LOCATION:	Willamalane Pool 1276 G St. Springfield OR 97477
FACILITY:	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Indoor, 25-yard pool with 8 lanes (7 feet per lane). Starting blocks at the shallow end of pool (5'6"). Deep end is 6'0".
CONCESSIONS:	There will be a small concession stand with snacks and drinks
SPECTATORS:	There will be a spectating area in the balcony above the pool. There is a separate entrance for spectators around the back side of the pool. We will livestream the event on our website www.teameugene.org . Look under the events/meets tab for a sub tab for this meet.

OFFICIALS:	We always appreciate the help of certified officials from other clubs. If you will be attending this meet, please sign up or notify the meet referee at least one week before the meet. If officials register for two or more sessions before 11/19 they get a free shirt. Officials can sign up to officiate at: https://forms.gle/iiVFfrPXdpZEDk59 All referees, starters, administrative officials, electronic timing officials, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in this sanctioned event, must be members of USA Swimming. The officials' uniform will be white shirts, black shorts/pants/skirt with black shoes.
ELIGIBILITY:	Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. No on deck meet registration will be permitted. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of the first day of the meet.
HOSPITALITY:	Drinks and small snacks will be provided throughout the meet.
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES:	Swimmers with disabilities are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.
ENTRIES:	<i>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When</i>

ENTRY DEADLINE:	Entries must be received no later than 11:59pm on November 17th 2021																																
ENTRY LIMIT:	Limit of 3 individual and 1 relays per day. The meet director reserves the right to limit entries in any event or eliminate events in order to stay within a reasonable time limit.

NO COACH PRESENT:	For unattached swimmers or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer's responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. Please see the Meet Director or the Meet Referee if assistance is needed upon arrival at the meet.																																
WARM-UP:	<p>USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming safety procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For warm-ups before the meet, each team will have an assigned lane to warm up their swimmers. There is a second small pool available for general warm-up as well. The small pool will also be available through the meet for warm-up and cool down. <p>Note: Swimmers violating safety procedures will be removed from the warm-up for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be removed from the remainder of the meet.</p>

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TIMELINE:	<p>The Meet Director reserves the right to change warm-up times as approved by the Referee. All coaches will be informed of any changes to warm-up and competition times. The Meet Referee reserves the right to remove or lengthen breaks written in the sanction as deemed appropriate for the success of the athletes.</p> <p>Due to the unknown number of athletes attending this meet, session timelines are tentative and subject to change. Once athletes are confirmed, a revised session timeline will be shared with all coaches prior to the meet.</p>																																



HEAT SHEETS:	Heat sheets with timelines will be available on the TEAM website in the 'Events' section prior to the meet.
MEETINGS:	Officials meetings will be held 45 minutes prior to the start of each session. Coaches meetings will be held 10 min prior to the start of each session.
TIMERS:	The meet will be run with two manual watches and buttons per lane in addition to a fully automated timing system.
RULES:	Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. All walkways around the pool and lifeguard stations must be kept clear. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual. Oregon Scratch Rules will not be enforced for this meet.
Scratches:	Coaches are HIGHLY encouraged to report scratches.
AWARDS AND SCORING:	Individual awards per age group and gender for timed finals/finals: 8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15&O. 1st – 3rd place individual medals. 4th- 12th place individual ribbons. High Point Award for top scoring girl and boy from each age group: 8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15&O Relays per age group and gender: 11-12, 13-14, 15&O 1st – 3rd place relay medals. 4th – 8th place relay ribbons. Team Awards -1st – 3rd place team trophies. SCORING Individual timed finals/finals scored by age groups: 8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15&O A Final: 1st – 8th place: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relays: 1st – 8th place: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2
RESTRICTIONS:	No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet. Tobacco, non-tobacco, vapor products of any kind, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. NO SHAVING PERMITTED. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Please change in designated changing areas or locker rooms only. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks at any time during the meet. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
SAFETY:	Oregon Swimming Safety Rules and Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AND RESTRICTIONS:	We have taken enhanced health and safety measures – for all swimmers, families, and coaches. You must follow all posted instructions while visiting TEAM Eugene Aquatics Pools. We will be following all applicable Oregon State, Lane County, and Willamalane Parks and Recreation District required COVID-19 health protocols in addition to what is listed in the rest of the safety section for the entirety of the meet. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests



with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By visiting this swim meet, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
