Updated Splashers Drop Off & Pick Up Procedures (6/18/21)

Enter via Regular Entrance: Beginning June 1, we will no longer be using the alternate drop-off/pick-up entrance on Jennings Street and are resuming our pre-COVID normal drop-off/pick-up procedures. As such, please enter the Aquatics Center using the South Lobby doors located on the plaza. There is a “drop zone” located on southbound Keeler Avenue next to the crosswalk/pavilion/plaza. Please do not park in the drop zone.

Safety Hazard: There is significant and dangerous demolition/construction taking place on the plaza outside the pool entrance. This area is fenced off. All lessons participants/visitors should obey all barriers and signage and all participants/spectators should be watchful and exercise caution in this area.

Drop Off & Pick Up: Lessons participants should be escorted to and from the lobby. Your child should wait inside the pool lobby after lessons if a parent/guardian hasn't arrived to pick the child up. Note that children are unsupervised if they are waiting outdoors because our staff members are on deck coaching—please remind your child that they should not wait outdoors.

Security Desk/Facility Access: All lessons participants must check in at the Security Desk in the South Lobby.

Arrive Early on the First Day of Classes: Please arrive 15 minutes early to complete facility waiver at the Security Desk. (rvs 6/18/21)

Masks & Social Distancing: Temperature scans are no longer being conducted. Masks are required for all children and lessons participants in the lobby, locker rooms/restrooms, and common areas. Masks do not have to be worn by lessons participants during class.

We ask that visitors not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 wear a mask in the lobby, locker rooms/restrooms, and common areas. Effective July 1, 2021, masks do not have to be worn in the facility by visitors who are fully vaccinated for COVID-19. (rvs 6/18/21)

Parent/Spectator Seating: The Aquatic Center bleachers will be open for spectator seating. If a person is not fully vaccinated for COVID-19, masks can be removed once seated in the bleachers, but social distancing should be maintained. (rvs 6/18/21)
