<b>Facility:</b>	The Natatorium at the C. David Howell Worthington Pools Complex is a 6-lane, 25-yard indoor facility with a fully automated timing system (Colorado touch pads and Daktronics Omnisport 2000 console). Water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3 1/2 inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls is as follow: From deep end: 8 feet (at 1 meter); and 12 feet (at 5 meters). From shallow end: 3 feet 11 inches (at 1 meter); 4 feet 9 inches (at 5 meters). The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4).

Arrangements for coach supervision must be made in advance of the meet.</li><li>• Any swimmer entered in the meet <u>must</u> be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li><li>• The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</li><li>• Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Registrations will not be accepted at the meet.</li> <li>• All adult athletes must hold current Athlete Protection Training certification.</li> <li>• Age on the first day of the meet will determine age for the entire meet.</li> </ul>
<b>Disability Swimmers:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ohio Swimming welcomes swimmers with a disability.</li> <li>• Entry Procedures: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter the USA-S swimmers with a disability electronically or on the paper entry form.</li> <li>2. Provide the grouping the swimmer is identified under (P1, P2, P3) and any necessary accommodations.</li> <li>3. List in the email with the electronic entry (or on the paper entry) the swimmer’s name, entry times, based on grouping (P1, P2, P3) strokes/distances and days/sessions.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• Preferred seeding is in the swimmer’s age group entered event at the same distance with their equivalent non-conforming time to ensure seeding in the initial heats.</li> <li>• See the Ohio Swimming Policy Book for Grouping descriptions (P1, P2, P3).</li> </ul>

**Entering the Meet**

<b>Entry Procedures:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Deadline for receipt of entries is <b>Thursday, November 4.</b></li><li>• Entries must be submitted in SCY using an electronic meet entry software (Hy-Tek/Team Unify).</li><li>• Unattached swimmers (not with a team) are encouraged to use Hytek's TM Lite for entry submission. Entries not completed through a team software are subject to a \$25/swimmer surcharge. These fees are due at the time of the entry submission.</li><li>• Send entries via email to: <b>coachbernard@worthingtonpools.com</b></li><li>• Please include the names of any Outreach swimmers in the email.</li><li>• Checks should be made payable to: <b>Worthington Swim Club Boosters</b></li><li>• "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted.</li><li>• The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries, if necessary, to manage the timeline and number of competitors and spectators at each session.</li></ul>
<b>Warm-up and Safety Guidelines:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The meet host will provide a complete schedule of warm-up procedures to include lane assignments and times, which must be adhered to by all participants. This information will be distributed in advance of the meet.</li><li>• Warm-ups will be monitored jointly by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees).</li><li>• Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner with one hand in contact with the pool deck.</li><li>• Ohio LSC Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warn-Up Procedures will be in effect for this meet.</li><li>• No spectators allowed on deck.</li></ul>
<b>Competition Guidelines:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This meet will be a timed finals meet.</li><li>• This meet will be contested in SCY.</li><li>• This meet will be contested combined gender. Results will be split by gender.</li><li>• This meet will be pre-seeded. Deck entries will/will not be accepted at the meet.</li><li>• There will be a bullpen for the 8 &amp; Under session only. For other sessions, Event and Heat numbers will be announced on a regular basis in the Championship Hall.</li></ul>
<b>Awards:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• There will be awards at this meet. Ribbons for top-6 finishers in each event in each age group (8 &amp; Under, 9-10, 11-12) and gender.</li><li>• Results will not be posted during the meet.</li></ul>

Facility Information	
<b>Facility Rules and Policies:</b>	<p>As the Ohio Department of Health releases updated recommendations for K-12 schools and other facilities, Worthington Pools remains committed to following the guidance set forth by state and local regulations. Worthington Pools is home to multiple sports teams. We value and are proud to host competitions for the community in a safe manner.</p> <p>Worthington Pools and SwimInc. cannot prevent you from being exposed to naturally occurring diseases while participating in events. If you choose to participate in OHSAA, USA swimming sanctioned events or other water based activities within our facility, you may be exposing yourself to or spreading COVID-19. We ask that all participants complete the Assumption of Risk, Release, and Waiver of Liability and Indemnification Agreement prior to beginning activity. The form discloses participants voluntarily accepting responsibility for any injury or damage while using the Worthington Pool.</p> <p>CDC specific guidelines for youth sporting events can be found here: <a href="https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/schools-childcare/youth-sports.html">https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/schools-childcare/youth-sports.html</a></p> <p><b>Facial Coverings:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Masks will be mandated for all patrons, athletes and employees.</li><li>• Coaches are required to wear a facial covering when entering, exiting and while in close proximity to others. When athletes are in the water, coaches are welcome to remove their masks while remaining socially distant.</li><li>• Athletes must wear facial coverings at all times when not in the water or exercising vigorously. This includes entering, exiting, during dryland and when in locker rooms.</li><li>• Spectators must wear facial coverings inside our facility throughout the duration of the event.</li></ul> <p><b>Congregating and Social Distancing:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Social distancing will be encouraged within our facilities. As a business focused on water sports, the transmission through chlorinated water is very low. Proper ventilation and filtration systems aid in the airflow throughout the space.</li><li>• The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) says that when swimming pools are properly maintained, the chlorine in the water should “inactivate” coronavirus, which would prevent the virus from spreading.</li><li>• If not fully vaccinated, the Ohio Department of Health recommends that individuals must maintain at least 6 feet of distance from others when possible.</li><li>• Locker rooms and showers will remain closed. Athletes should come and go wearing their swim suit. Deck changing is prohibited.</li><li>• The Championship Hall will reopen for teams area. Athletes must maintain reasonable social distance from other athletes throughout the duration of the event.</li><li>• Water fountain will be used for the water bottle refill feature only.</li><li>• Spectators must maintain reasonable social distance from other families throughout the duration of the event. Those who are fully vaccinated and wear facial coverings may congregate in small groups.</li></ul> <p><b>Testing and Quarantine:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Those who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to self-isolate for 10 days and be cleared by the board of health before reentering the facility.</li><li>• Those who suspect exposure, present symptoms or have been contacted must present a negative COVID-19 test prior to resuming normal athletic activity. The group’s responsible party (coach, swim lesson instructor, etc). will be responsible for validating this test.</li></ul> <p><b>Temperature checks:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Temperature checks are not required upon entrance to the facility. We reserve the right to check patrons who present symptoms.</li></ul> <p><b>Sanitization:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Worthington pools will frequently sanitize and disinfect high contact surfaces.</li><li>• In the event of a positive COVID-19 case within our facility, Worthington Pools reserves the right to shut down the facility for deep cleaning and ample filtration. be prohibited.</li></ul>

These are potential guidelines our facility is prepared to implement if need be:</b></p> <p><b>Masking:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Due to the delta strand being twice as contagious as the original strand, masks will be required for all patrons, athletes and employees who enter the facility, regardless of vaccination status when not in the water.</li> </ul> <p><b>Congregating and Social Distancing:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social distancing will be strongly enforced. Teams will be required to sit in designated chairs on the pool deck and start at staggered positions within the pool.</li> <li>• Locker rooms will close.</li> <li>• Equipment sharing will be prohibited.</li> <li>• Championship hall will close.</li> <li>• Frequent sanitization of high-contact surfaces.</li> </ul> <p><b>Testing and Quarantine:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Those who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to work closely with contact tracing and the board of health to be cleared from self isolation before reentering the facility.</li> <li>• Those who suspect exposure or have been contacted must present a negative COVID-19 test prior to resuming normal athletic activity. The group's responsible party (coach, swim lesson instructor, etc) will be responsible for validating this test.</li> <li>• In the event of a large outbreak, at the discretion of management, the facility may shut down for 24 hours to deep clean and allow the filtration to cycle through. The impacted team will be forced to isolate and pause activity.</li> </ul> <p>This policy is subject to change at the discretion of Worthington Pools. We will do fly-over (dive-over) starts.</p> <p>If you use the restrooms, spray all touched surfaces upon leaving the locker room (assuming spray sanitizer available at facility).</p> <p>Locker rooms are not available for changing before or after the meet.</p> <p>When not in the water, athletes are expected to wear a mask at all times, including when walking to and from an event and/or warm-up lanes.
