Each family will need to complete volunteer sessions (or equivalent – see attached Table) throughout the year at other meets or team activities based on their children's squad membership.

- Volunteer requirement for ***families with more than one swimmer*** equals the session requirement for the swimmer in the highest squad plus half of the session requirement for the next highest swimmer, up to 2 swimmers.
(e.g. Swimmer 1 in Gold + swimmer 2 in Bronze = 6.5 sessions [5 + 1.5])
- \$35 fee for outstanding sessions not worked (billed July 31, 2020)

The intent of this policy is not to collect more fees, but to enable the Carson Tigersharks to maintain the high-quality standards that the team exemplifies when we all work together. CARSON TIGERSHARKS VOLUNTEER SESSION EQUIVALENTS

- A session at a swim meet is approximately 4-6 hours in length. In order to obtain credit for those hours you must stay and work the entire session. Leaving before the end of the session will forfeit your hours and not count toward your volunteering obligation. If you work a session that is half (or less) than the 4-6-hour amount, it will be considered half a session. If the session runs longer than the 4-6-hour amount, credit will be given as another partial session.
- Your children under the age of 18 can fulfill **up to half** of the family volunteering commitment, however, they will only count towards half of your required sessions. Adult supervision may be required in some positions.
- There will be a Carson Tigersharks Volunteer Log binder maintained in the office at the pool. Each family will have a separate page and ***are responsible to record the jobs worked, dates, sessions/hours completed and sign to validate.***
- Job lists will be posted on the wall in the office for upcoming volunteering events.
