

Carson Tigersharks Code of Conduct

The Carson Tigersharks Swim Team is committed to providing an enjoyable and complete swimming experience for swimmers of all age and abilities. It is the tradition of the team to provide a challenging and positive teaching and training environment in which swimmers can develop a sense of self-esteem and pride through individual and team achievement. In accordance with the objectives of USA swimming the Carson Tigersharks will practice the ideals of integrity and fairness; provide a positive environment; and strive for excellence in leadership, innovation and creativity. Swimmers are given opportunities to learn personal responsibility, accountability, sportsmanship and citizenship. The coaches and club administrators expect all participants, swimmers and parents to adhere to these principles.

Expected Behaviors

1. Practice sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and demonstrating positive support for all (swimmers, coaches, parents, officials, guests) at all times.
2. Practice teamwork with all parents, swimmers and coaches supporting the values of discipline, loyalty, commitment and hard work.
3. Adhere to all Rules and Procedures provided to swimmers and parents by the Tigersharks Coaching Staff.
4. Maintain self control at all times.
5. Use civil language at all times.
6. Swimmers are to maintain a lifestyle that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.
7. Personal relationships shall not be allowed to impact negatively any swimmers' full participation in workouts or competition.

The Code of Conduct serves as a standard to emphasize the Carson Tigersharks commitment to providing for all a positive experience for all. Any violation of the Code of Conduct perceived by a Coach, swimmer or parent will be addressed and handled in an individual manner by that Coach, by the Board of Directors or the Head Coach. In certain cases, violation of the Code of Conduct may result in temporary or permanent suspension from the Carson Tigersharks Swim Team.

By signing the Code of Conduct, each family is acknowledging the existence of the expected behaviors and the commitment to act accordingly.
