HONOR CODE

This Honor Code and any additional guidelines regarding conduct will be reviewed by The Head Coach prior to departure on any Santa Clara Swim Club (SCSC) sponsored team travel.

Upon notification of any violation of the Honor Code, a review committee (consisting of the CEO/Head Coach, the coach of the swimmer, if not the Head Coach, and a non-coach member of SCSC, female if the violator is female, male if the violator is male) shall promptly investigate the circumstances of the violation, notify the individual(s) charged of a time for hearing, and shall conduct an informal hearing on the evidence. This review committee shall then promptly determine what disciplinary action, if any, shall be taken. It is the responsibility of the CEO/Head Coach to report the violations and disciplinary action, if any, to the Board of Directors of Santa Clara Swim Club.

I, _____ as a member of SCSC understand and will comply with the following as approved by the Head Coach of the Santa Clara Swim Club. Besides the below mentioned, I will also comply with all policies listed in the attached travel policy document.

- 1) The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, or controlled substances are prohibited throughout the designated

duration of the trip.

- 2) Curfews will be established and adhered to during the trip.
- 3) Attendance is required at all team functions which include, but are not limited to, meetings, practices, exhibitions, press conferences, and competitions unless otherwise excused or instructed by the Head Coach, or designated person in charge of the team.
- 4) Only athletes assigned to a particular room are allowed to occupy the room. No other athletes are allowed in a non-assigned room at any time.
- 5) Uniform requirements established for the trip will be followed.
- 6) Proper respect, sportsmanship, and courtesy towards coaches, officials, administrators, competitors, fellow team members, and the public will be displayed.
- 7) The manner in which one behaves will present a positive image of SCSC and will provide an atmosphere to meet the competitive performance objectives.
- 8) Additional guidelines may be established as needed to assure the safety and well being of the team members and will be adhered to during the trip.

I understand that failure to comply with the Santa Clara Swim Club Honor Code as set forth in this document or additions necessary for the safety and well being of the team members may result in disciplinary actions which may include, but not limited to the following:

- 1) Disqualification from one or more swimming activities sponsored by SCSC
- 2) Dismissal from team and returned home at own/personal expense
- 3) The infraction(s) will be reported to the CEO/Head Coach, if (s)he was not on the trip and further disciplinary actions may take place which include, but are not limited to suspension from SCSC for a period of time. It is the responsibility of the CEO/Head Coach to report the violations and disciplinary action, if any, to the Board of Directors of Santa Clara Swim Club.
