Storm Aquatics is a competitive swimming program based in Lake Stevens, WA. It is a non-profit volunteer organization with a group of involved parents participating as members of the board of directors. We have developed a quality program that will meet the needs of all those interested in learning more about competitive swimming. Levels within our program have been established to meet the needs of new and experienced swimmers of all ages.
