Colonial Swim League Waiver Print

Colonial Swim League Waiver



The Colonial Swimming League exists to promote healthy, friendly competitive and safe swimming opportunities for my child(ren). It is a non-profit organization run by volunteers for the benefit of its members, including me. I support and participate in the League and its sanctioned activities either directly through my child(ren). We derive the intended benefit of safe, friendly competition and other such benefits from our participation. For that reason, and with an explicit understanding of the consequences of doing so, I, as parent or legal guardian of the child(ren) named above, agree that I will not file suit or cooperate in any suit brought on behalf of my child(ren) against the League, or its officers, or any other member team, coaches, officers, or any pool organization sponsoring a Colonial Swim League team or its coaches or officers, for any injury suffered by my child(ren) in the course of League sponsored competition, including swim meets, warm-ups, and practices, unless the injury is the result of gross negligence, meaning willful misconduct of the party sued. I further agree, in consideration of the above described benefits, that if I do initiate or am a party to litigation in which gross negligence is alleged, and that lawsuit is unsuccessful, I will reimburse the party(ies) sued for their legal fees and costs associated with that lawsuit.

Pool Deck Supervision Print

Pool Deck Supervision



The Barrington Pool rules state that children 10 and older may swim at the pool unaccompanied by a parent/guardian or responsible adult only if they pass the basic Swim Test conducted by the Head Lifeguard. The Swim Test consists of competently swimming the length of the pool without stopping, and treading in deep water continuously for one minute. The Barrington Blue Fins adheres to this policy.

Children who have not passed the swim test must have on-deck supervision at all times during practice sessions and meets. Parents/guardians are not allowed to drop off their swimmers and leave the pool deck without designated supervision. Supervision can be in the form of a parent/guardian, daycare provider, or a designated minor (who is at least 13 years or older, has passed the swim test and is responsible for the swimmer).

To designate a non-parent/guardian supervisor, the parent/guardian must complete this Pool Deck Supervision form. This form must be signed by: the parent/guardian, the designated supervisor (adult/minor), and the Head Coach. This form should be given to the Head Coach of the Blue Fins at the first practice.

Swim Practice Etiquette Contract



There is a no tolerance rule for excessive talking, disruptive (pinching, spashing, dunking, hitting) or distracting behavior. There is a no tolerance rule for teasing and bullying other swimmers or siblings.

Constructive punitive actions will be used to curb disruptive behavior (e.g., warnings, sit out a set, sit out a practice, lane switch, push-ups/sit ups, extra laps, removal from team as a last resort).

Your parents will be consulted if behavior doesn't improve after repeated warnings.

Competition Behavior and Etiquette

Learn appropriate competition behavior:

- arrive on time for warm ups
- report to coaches to secure meet event cards
- keep your event card with your competition gear (goggles/cap) at all times
- pay attention to event order so that you are ready to proceed to Clerk of Course at appointed time
- report to the Head/Assistant Coach following your event
- participate in cheers to boost team spirit during competition

Learn appropriate competition sportsmanship:

- do not look around during your event
- direct attention to coach if told to do so
- remain in the pool after your event until all swimmers finish
- shake the hand of swimmers in lanes to the left and to the right
- exit water as directed by the timers
