Welcome to the 58th Annual Contra Costa County Swim Championship, one of the oldest and largest recreational swim meets in the United States. We are very pleased to host this prestigious event at Acalanes High School.

We are delighted to be recognized by the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors honoring all the swimmers and volunteers at the 2018 Contra Costa County Championship Swim Meet. The County Meet brings together the top swimmers from the County's top recreational swim teams. There are over 2,000 swimmers competing from 58 teams, which represent roughly 12,000 summer recreational swimmers. This Meet is all about recognizing these exceptional athletes. Congratulations to all 2018 County Qualifiers!

Again this year, we will hold Finals for the 1st through 10th fastest swimmers in the preliminary heats and Consolation Finals for the 11th through 20th fastest swimmers in Freestyle, Breaststroke, Backstroke and Butterfly. Consolation Finals will be held immediately prior to the Finals for each event. The Individual Medley will be timed finals only. Medley Relay and Free Relay trials will be held on Friday evening. One heat of Championship Finals for 1st through 10th place will be the last event of the finals session each day. Medley Relay finals will be on Saturday, Free Relay finals will be on Sunday. 11th through 20th place relay teams in the preliminary heats will still score points, but will not compete in the finals session.

Each Individual Event Qualifier will receive a 2018 commemorative Contra Costa County Swim Championship pin honoring their achievement.
