Here is the latest LP News...

Facility Capacity & Checking the Patron Counter

- **Governor Wolf has said outdoor gatherings in PA must be 250 people or less.**
- LPSC typical day capacity is 250 people including staff
- LPSC special event capacity is 200 people plus staff—the reason our special event capacity is less than a typical day is that our special events are centered around the pool itself—meaning more people will want to be in the water or on the main deck and less people will be using the lower level or playground.
- **Please Check Patron Counter **BEFORE** coming to the pool!**
 - **CLICK HERE** for our patron counter (it's also located at the top of our homepage!)
 - Counter is updated every 20 minutes
 - Please note that the Capacity will be set at 250 most days/times but will change to 200 during float nights, flick & floats or any other special event we have.
 - If we are at capacity when you get to the pool, you will need to wait until the next count in order to enter. We have not hit 250 people yet this year,

even on the hottest day, so I do not anticipate this occurring more than a handful of times this season (if it happens at all)

COVID-19 Safety Procedures **UPDATED!**

- As you read through the list below, you'll notice that they are in place in **COMMUNAL** areas of our facility.
 - I realize that each family is practicing different levels of social distancing with friends and acquaintances BUT as a club we need to follow protocols that all ALL members to use the facility as safely as possible during this pandemic.
 - Every patron is in a unique situation with regards to their own health and risk factors as well as their family members.
 - In order to remain open and comply with local and state health agencies, LPSC staff members will be enforcing the following rules.
- **MASKS REQUIRED at Entry**—we have a limited supply of disposable masks in the office if a patron forgets theirs at home.
 - Any person 3 years or older refusing to wear a mask at entry will not be permitted into the facility. If you have a medical exception, please ask to speak with the manager or COVID Guard.
 - Using the collar of your shirt or a towel is NOT an acceptable face covering.
- **MASKS REQUIRED at all indoor spaces**—Snack Bar & Locker Room
 - ONLY exception is while you are seated at snack bar table EATING or DRINKING.
- **MASKS REQUIRED at the desk**—

- When you exit or want to speak with the desk attendant, Manager or Duty or COVID Guard, you must wear your mask.
- ***MASKS STRONGLY SUGGESTED*** when traveling on a congested deck.
- ***Diving Board & Slide Social Distancing REQUIRED***—
 - We have added markers approximately 6 feet apart for when patrons are waiting in line for the slide and diving board
 - These are communal pieces of equipment and while a certain group of children or adults may not be practicing physical distancing with each other, there may be other members also waiting in line who want physical distance.
 - As a community, we need to allow for all members to safely use these communal pieces of equipment.

- **Mon, August 3rd**—FLOAT Night from 6:00-7:50pm! —Baby Pool CLOSED during Float Night

Lost & Found to be Thrown Away on Wednesday Nights!

- As we said before the season, with COVID-19 we were not permitting members to leave any toys/floats behind each night.
- A small “lost and found” has formed at the front desk.
- Staff will be disposing of all items every Wednesday evening at closing—so check out the front desk area if you’ve left something at the pool recently!

Steps Taken by LPSC for YOUR Safety

- A specific staff member during all club operational hours that will answer patron questions, periodically disinfect bathrooms and high touch surfaces (ladders, railings, swings) through out the day. Look for the staff member in the yellow shirt!
- Plexiglass barriers installed at the front desk and snack bar counter.
- Hand Sanitizer stations in the snack bar and at the front desk.
- Safe disinfectant available at the snack bar should a patron want to disinfect a picnic table prior to eating. Staff members will also periodically clean tables.
- Removal of card and board game rentals. We still have ping pong, shuffle board and basketballs! Equipment will be disinfected after each use.
- Markers have been placed 6 feet apart for patrons to wait in line for the diving board and slide.

Arrival

- All patrons 3 years and older must wear a mask at entry and all patrons will have their temperature taken. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4°F will not be permitted to enter.

- Patrons 12 years and older are eligible to stay at LPSC by themselves, but whoever brings them to the pool needs to wait until the child's temperature is taken before they depart.
- We have an extra staff member to assist the desk attendant, but should there be a line at the entrance, please maintain a 6 foot distance between your family and the family in front of you.
- NO Guests for opening weekend. Guests are permitted during the week and will most likely be permitted starting the weekend of June 27-28 as Delaware Co. will be in the "Green Phase" at that point.

While at the Club

- Masks should be worn when inside the locker room, when in line and ordering at the snack bar, or when speaking to a staff member with whom you cannot socially distance.
- Masks are optional while on the deck, playground or lower level.
- Masks are NOT permitted while in the main or baby pool.
- Our typical pool rules are still in effect— [CLICK HERE](#) for LPSC Rules.
- Life guards are in place for patron safety in the pool, on the deck and on the surrounding grounds. Parents are responsible for their child(ren)'s behavior while at the club—it is a parent responsibility to ensure that their child maintains social distance from other patrons as the parent sees fit.

- Be sure to check out our improvements to the “lower level”—it’s more important than ever to utilize as much of the club grounds as possible and we have painted the shuffle board courts, added two new basketball nets, painted lines on the basketball court and added a net for volleyball or badminton.
