

## **Lawrence Park Swim Club Meeting Notes 5/26/20**

Dear LPSC Families

The Lawrence Park Swim Club will open on Saturday, June 20. After 6/5 only credit cards will be accepted during registration.

The pool hours will be from 10:30 to 8:00 PM Monday – Sunday.

Snack Bar will open from 11:00-7:00 PM daily.

While in yellow phase of reopening, we will implement the following changes to our normal operations. These changes are intended to mitigate potential spread of COVID-19 in our community and meet state and CDC requirements for maintaining social distancing and sanitization standards.

We have added a staff position to assist throughout the day with a focus on meeting COVID 19 standards.

The following changes have been made:

### **Bring your own chairs.**

Please remember this is only temporary. Once the region goes to green we will bring back our club chairs.

### **Bring a Mask**

Masks will be worn upon entry, when entering/ordering snack shop, and utilizing the bathroom. Masks are NOT to be worn in the pool, as they should not get wet.

They are only worn on deck if not social distancing. The COVID manager and desk attendants will have masks. Lifeguards on duty will not be masked.

### **Limit Toys**

Please limit your child to 1 or 2 favorite toys and take them home each day. We will not be able to clean or store pool toys. If toys are left at the club, they will be thrown away during the evening clean.

### **Entering the Club**

Our staff will have daily temperature checks. We are preparing to operate under the recommendation that guests also have temperature checks. We are utilizing plexiglass barriers to protect our front desk staff. Please be patient as we check in each family. Please stand 6 feet apart from other families in cue. In order to limit interactions at the desk, registrations and registration payments must be made online prior to coming to the pool.

### **Capacity Limits**

We have a large comfortable facility, with several active zones that provide room to separate family groups. In an effort to limit our crowds on weekends, we will divide the day into shifts and provide links to register for the shifts online. A maximum of 40 families will be able to register per shift. An invitation/letter will be sent each Tuesday to sign up for the following weekend and the link will be added to the website.

### **Guests Limited**

In order to maintain capacity, guests are limited to 2 per family on weekdays/ no guests on weekends. Exceptions/accommodations will be made if the guest is a designated caregiver or immediate family member. We realize some bond holders bring partner/spouse as a guest.

### **Supervise Children**

While the pool rules state that children 12 and up can attend without an adult, we strongly discourage this during yellow phase. Parents must stay on site at least through the check in process. If they have a temperature, they will not be allowed to enter. They will need to follow pool rules as well as COVID requirements and social distancing. Once on deck, our staff cannot be responsible for identifying who is within your family or quarantine group. Unsupervised children who are not being respectful to others or following pool rules will be sent home.

### **Events**

We are postponing or cancelling events for now; this includes Family Day, Pre-Teen Splash, Flick and Floats. We will bring back celebrations when we go green. For now, let's enjoy being outside.

### **Snack Bar and Playground**

To create more space between families in the snack bar, we are moving picnic tables around the playground area. No food or drink other than water is allowed on the Pool Deck. Please bring water bottles; we had to remove the water fountain.

The playground area will be opened most of the day. We will close for 15 minutes, three times/daily for cleaning. We will keep available sport equipment that is easy for desk attendants to clean, such as ping-pong and basketball. We will not have board games or cards available for checkout.

### **Showers**

The showers will be turned off after morning Master Class. The changing rooms are still available for privacy.

Thank you for your patience as we implement these plans. As bond-holding members, we all own this club and want to see it thrive. We want our families and staff to be safe.
