



### 2020 Season: What to Know

As we embark on what is sure to be a memorable summer season, the Staff and Board of Governors want to make sure our members are aware of a number of policies and procedures that will be implemented to create a safer environment. The first of which is.....

### **STAY HOME!!**

Any member that has symptoms of COVID-19, has tested positive for COVID-19 or thinks he or she was exposed to someone with COVID-19 during the past 14 days must not come to the pool.

### **Club Access**

- KSC will be open from 10:00am - 9:00pm daily this summer.
- We'll be operating at a maximum capacity of 325. If we get close to that number, you will be alerted via text or email.
- The main pool and baby pool will have a limited capacity of 150 and 30 respectively.
- We are prepared to implement a reservation system if necessary.
- Members are required to wear masks upon entry/exit and in high traffic areas (snack bar, bathroom, etc.) They are not required on the grounds and are PROHIBITED in the pool.
- The grass will be marked with approximately 400sq ft plots to help families maintain social distancing.
- Parents are always responsible for the actions of their children, especially considering the potential for a small child to wander into another members' family plot. Parents need to be active managers of their children and ensure they understand and respect the safety of others at all times.
- Disregarding the rules and instructions of lifeguards and staff will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action from the Board.
- All adult members (age 18 and over) will be required to sign a COVID-19 waiver prior to using the pool. All minors must be included on an adult's signed waiver prior to using the pool.
- Guests will not be permitted until further notice. It is our hope to welcome guests in some capacity at some point later this summer.
- Children under the age of 14 are not permitted without a chaperone. The minimum age of a chaperone is 14.

### **Limitations**

- Basketball courts are closed for ball-play. Picnic tables spread out on blacktop may be utilized.

- The slide will be closed indefinitely.
- The snack bar will operate in accordance with the rules established by the Haverford Township Department of Public Health. Further details will be announced.
- The bathroom showers are closed.
- Only personal chairs are permitted. Chairs may be stored or taken home overnight. Members are asked to refrain from “stacking” their chairs with those belonging to other members.
- No club-provided pool toys/games/athletic equipment. Members may bring toys for the baby pool and diving toys such as rings/torpedoes for personal use. Other toys may be permitted at the Manager’s discretion.
- Staff are required to wear masks with the exception of lifeguards on the stand. Members are asked to refrain from talking to on-duty lifeguards and instead, direct questions to managers and desk staff.
- Special events and birthday parties will not be scheduled until further notice.

### **Weather**

- In the event of weather that necessitates the closure of the pools, the entire facility must be vacated due to the lack of a structure large enough to shelter large groups.
