

## All City Swim 2023 Volunteering Requirements

We are **very** excited to be hosting our first All-City Swim Meet (July 27-29) when more than 2,000 swimmers and their families will come to Goodman to participate in this annual Madison tradition. To pull off this tremendous event, we will need your help. Apart from our amazing coaching staff, every hour of work that goes into the Goodman Waves is on a volunteer basis. To make our team work, hundreds of volunteer hours are needed.

When you register your child as a member of the Goodman Swim and Dive Team, you must also commit to serve as a volunteer to help make the team a success. Volunteering has always been a very important part of the Goodman Swim and Dive Team – but in 2023 the expectations will be stepped up a notch!

**To register your child for the team this year – we require you to volunteer for three (3) spots (per parent) for the All-City Swim Meet. This is REQUIRED to be part of our team and for your child to be able to participate in the All-City Swim Meet. Athletes will not be allowed to participate in practice or meets until the volunteer sign-ups are complete. No exceptions.**
