Rules and Regulations for use of Swimming Pool Facilities

General Kent Swim and Tennis Club Rules

1. All groups must leave the facility in a condition considered satisfactory to the Manager in charge who will supervise any cleanup activities. Failure to do so may result in additional fees charged to the renting party.
2. Violations of Kent Swim and Tennis Club rules and regulations, policies or procedures or the violation of any applicable city, county, state, or federal statute by the renting party shall be cause for immediate termination.

Pool Rules

1. Lifeguard directions/warnings will be followed at all times.
2. Showers are required before swimmers enter the pool area.
3. Running, pushing, or horseplay is not allowed.
4. Diving is allowed in designated areas only.
5. No one is allowed on starting blocks.
6. Playing on the deck equipment (ladders, diving boards rails) is not allowed.
7. No back jumps, back dives, or any type of somersaults from the side of the pool.
8. No shoulder rides or dunking allowed.
9. No hanging or swimming on lane lines.
10. One person on the diving board at a time.
11. Divers must immediately swim to the ladder and exit the pool.
12. One bounce only on the diving board.
13. One person on diving board at a time.
14. Divers must jump or dive straight off the end of the board.
15. No running on the dive board.
16. Glass objects are not allowed in the locker room or pool area.
17. The use of masks, fins, snorkels, and other swimming aids must be cleared with the lifeguards.
18. Children wearing Coast Guard Approved floatation devices must be accompanied by an adult with arms reach at all times (One child per adult) and are not allowed in the dive tank.
19. Kickboards are for use in the lap lane only.

The Pool Manager or Senior Lifeguard on duty is in charge at all times. Their primary concern is health and safety. Therefore, failure to follow above stated rules or any additional rules that are deemed necessary by the Manager will result in the loss of swimming privileges.
