Sanctioned By: Florida Swimming of USA Swimming #.

Condition of Sanction: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

- Type of Meet: 25 Yard Short Course
6 & Under Timed Finals, Relay Timed Finals
8 & Under, 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18 preliminaries, finals and consolation finals.
- Date and Time: Championship finals will be swum prior to consolation finals.
Saturday and Sunday June 8 & 9, 2013
Prelim Session will begin at 9:00 AM, Saturday and Sunday
6&U Session will begin Sunday at 1:00 pm. 6&U warm-ups will begin at 12:15 and end at 12:50
Finals will begin at 5:00 PM on Saturday and Sunday
Warm-up for morning prelims begins at 7:00 am both days.
Warm-up for finals begins at 4:00pm Saturday and Sunday.
2 warm-up and cool-down lanes east of the competition lanes to be used during the meet
- Eligibility Open to all registered USA Swimming athletes who are members of invited summer teams in good standing with the Private Club League
- Location: Gandy Pool, Kelly Recreation Complex

- Pool Specifications: Certified 25 Yard, outdoor pool w/10 short course racing lanes having a minimum depth of 12 feet, at the starting end of the pool. Non-turbulent lane lines. 10 lanes for prelims and timed finals and 8 lanes for finals. Water depth at the competition starting end is a minimum of 10 feet, and the turn end is a minimum of 4 feet, 0 inches. No starting blocks on the shallow end of the pool - 6&U and 8&U will start from the deck.
- Timing: Daktronics Timing System with scoreboard.
- Warm-up: General warm-up: 7:00 am for Saturday and Sunday prelims with assigned teams
A Coach must be present on the deck when his/her team is warming up.
Warm-up for 6&U Session will start at 12:15 pm on Sunday.
There are 10 lanes and 9 teams. Larger teams, please do not occupy more than one lane until you are sure a smaller team has vacated their lane.
- Finals One hour warm-up prior to each Final Session - 4pm for Saturday and Sunday.
Each Championship Final will be swum first so that vacancies can be filled from the Consolation Final. Consolation Final qualifiers are asked to be at the designated block to be considered for any vacancies in Championship Final. Alternate Final qualifiers are asked to be standing behind Starter at the time of the Consolation Fin
- Closed Meet

Seeding: 25 yard short course times will be used for seeding,

Entry Limit: Limited to (3) three individual events and (2) two relays per swimmer. Each team may enter **only one relay team** per event.

Entry Form: Over entries will automatically be dropped when they exceed the meet limit. Entries must be submitted on HyTek export format accompanied by a hard copy and payment. Teams choosing to submit entries in hard copy form only will be charged an additional \$50, 00. Entries will be accepted via e-mail to eva@swimresultsbytrg.com.

Entry Fee: E-Mail entries must be accompanied by a backup hard copy of the entry, list of all attending coaches, contact phone numbers, and a summary of financial information as outlined on the Master Entry Form. Current USA Swimming registration number, full name, age, and entry time must be listed. All entry and Master Entry Forms must be signed.

Checks should be made payable to "Lakeland Yacht & Country Club" and must be sent to Martha Simons, at 929 Lake Hollingsworth Dr., Lakeland FL 33803 and received on or before June 7th. All entries must be paid in full before the meet starts.

Warm-Up Procedures: Absolutely no equipment at any time. Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck, except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach.

Scratches: PRELIMS: No penalty for scratches on the blocks.

FINALS: Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies in the top 16 as originally seeded, must swim in that event's final or consolation final; or must submit their intention to scratch from that event within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers. Swimmers may reverse their intention to scratch and choose to be seeded for finals if they do so within 30 minutes of their last event of the day. Any swimmer seeded in a final who fails to swim that event will be barred from further competition in the meet, unless excused by the Meet Referee because of illness or emergency. The Meet Referee must be notified prior to the event taking place. Coaches are encouraged to scratch swimmers seeded in the top 24 if not returning for finals. If there is an open lane in the Championship finals, the fastest qualifier in consolation finals will be offered that lane. Designated alternates wishing to swim in open lanes in consolation finals must check in with the deck referee and stand at the starters table ready to swim when the swimmers are called to the blocks. Only the starter may call for alternates.

- Rules: 2011 USA Swimming Rules and PCL By-Laws will govern the Meet. A declared false start under 102.14.5D or deliberate delay of meet under 102.14.7 A is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.
- Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet.
- Team Rep: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person, other than the Coach, who will check with the referee about any matters pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. For each team, the Coach and that person ONLY will be recognized.
- Each team must **provide 3 timers** for Prelims and Finals both Saturday and Sunday and for the 6&U session. Teams must submit a list of timers by June 4th via email to: Gene Moore at gene.moore@earthlink.net

- Coaches Meeting: 8:30 AM Saturday and Sunday in the Hospitality Room
- Use of Cameras Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.12, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
