



## 2019 Junior Coach Application

The Lenah Run Froggers Swim team is seeking professional, dedicated, mature Junior Coaches for the 2019 summer season. We are looking for coaches that want to take a leadership position in our team's development. The successful candidate should possess the following skill set:

- Possess a high level of maturity, sportsmanship and leadership ability
- Possess willingness to respect, work and cooperate with other coaches, swim team members, parents, and any other members or guests of Lenah Run
- Demonstrate energy and enthusiasm for teaching and motivating young swimmers of all ability levels including pre-competitive and competitive level swimmers
- Possess a depth of knowledge and ability to teach and develop proper swimming techniques;
  - Emphasizes stroke and turn fundamentals with encouragement and praise
  - Uses demonstrations and / or presentations
  - Provides constructive feedback
- Understand swim team practice training procedures and keep athletes engaged in productive activity
- Understand standards of behavior and use appropriate discipline when necessary
- Knowledge of latest safety standards and information related to aquatics; Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR is a plus
- Must be 15 years old by June 1st, 2019, if only 15 years old **MAY BE REQUIRED** to be lifeguard certified before the first day of practice; if this will be necessary please provide dates of scheduled classes you plan on taking for certification and location; will be determined based on coaching staff selected for the given season

**Responsibilities for the Junior Coach position:** further explanation of responsibilities will be detailed in Junior Coach contract to be discussed with offer of position

- Reports directly to Head Coach (HC) and as such, issues should be brought to HC attention
- Arrive early to first scheduled practice session every day and arrive early to meets to ensure set up is complete
- Stays after to last scheduled practice session every day and at meets to ensure proper cleanup and debrief as needed and meets
- Available for stroke / DQ clinics, as needed and directed by the HC
- If unable to attend a practice, clinic, or meet provides proper notification to HC
- If unable to arrive on time or to attend own practice session, may not coach for the day unless a valid reason has been given to and approved by the HC -- whether the reason is valid or not is at the discretion of the HC
- Pay is deducted for each day of missed coaching -- after 3 days of unexcused absences from coaching, the HC and Froggers Board have the authority to dismiss them from their position
- Conduct practice sessions with stroke coaching and drills under the guidance of the HC
- Expected to work at meets – duties will be further defined in the employment contract
- Ensure that safety is exercised during all swim team activities
- Praise swimmer progress or redirect them to the goal at hand -- Keep it simple and positive
- Attend team building activities and display leadership and enthusiasm
- Help with cheers, make pep rallies fun by participating and supporting the team



### Application Process

- Junior Coach candidates must be 15 years old by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year.
- In an attempt to provide as many interested swimmers the opportunity to be Junior Coaches, these positions are valid for one season and do not guarantee a Junior Coaching position for the next season. An application must be submitted for each season.
- Swimmers interested in the position should submit an application to the Froggers Board based on direction received by the indicated date.
- Items that will be considered in the selection process are:
  - number of years the candidate has been swimming
  - maturity level of candidate
  - previous history of being prompt and responsible
  - ability to take direction from Coaches
  - experience working with younger kids, such as, babysitting or volunteer work
  - candidate's application stating why they are interested in the position
  - current season coaching staff
- Candidates must be available for an interview if requested.
- Review and Final Approval of candidates will be voted by the Froggers Board. If parents of Junior Coach candidates are on the Froggers Board, they must recuse themselves in the interview process. Although, they may provide opinions and feedback.
- Applications will be accepted **from now until March 1<sup>st</sup>**. All applications should be sent to Dawn Foley at dawn@foleycorp.com or at the address below. Interviews will be conducted if deemed necessary by the Board. Selected coaches will be notified by email.
- Junior Coaches must sign a Contract for final acceptance. The contract will include additional details regarding job responsibilities and dates for scheduled activities / availability.
- Junior Coaches will be paid bi-weekly.
