

All parents wishing to get their \$100 deposit back need to complete 90 points of work during the season. Each shift counts for 10 points, the positions are as follows.

Zoo Keeper: A Zoo keeper is assigned to each age group and each gender. The role of the Zoo keeper is to make sure the kids are ready to go to the ready bench when called, in other words babysit.

Head Zoo Keeper: Manage all of the zoo keepers and make sure there is always supervision present.

Get Ready: Organize all of the kids by lane assignment and race and heat number, crucial job to make the meet run smoothly.

Lane Timers: Sit at the end of each lane during the race and push plungers when race starts and ends.

Starter: Call swimmers to the block and start races

Announcer: Gives announcements, mc of the meet keeps things moving.

Stroke and Turn judges: Make sure all strokes done properly and touches are done properly and false starts. (Must be certified for this assignment)

Ribbons: Attach names and time to ribbons as races finish

Runners: Work between scorer's table stroke and turn judges and timers.

Snack Bar: Work the snack bar.

Hospitality: Keep the workers on the swim deck hydrated and hand out snacks as needed.

Scorer's Table: Use the scorer computer to verify all times and outcomes and reset for each race.

In addition, you are required to work at least 1 shift at our fireworks booth, and one shift each day of championships. (those spots will be filled prior to championships further information will be provided)
