

## **SPRING 2021 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES as of May 12, 2021.**

- Per county code your swimmers must have a COVID-19 CHECK-IN. **Swimmers must arrive on time for the COVID-19 CHECK-IN time.** If you are late for your COVID CHECK-IN time, your swimmer may not be allowed into the complex and swim practice. We have made a commitment to you and our community to run a safe program, it is everyone's responsibility to follow the guidelines and rules. Masks must be worn by swimmers while in line for their COVID-19 CHECK-IN, waiting for practice to begin and upon exiting practice.
- Swimmers must come dressed in their suit and cap. Coaches or other swimmers will not be able to cap your child. They must have their cap on prior COVID-19 CHECK-IN. **Cap and goggles are required for practice.**
- Swimmers must maintain a distance of at least six feet apart while in line for COVID-19 CHECK-IN and at ALL times on the pool deck. The deck will be marked to aid swimmers with this.
- **Swimmers must be picked up/leave the complex immediately** after swim practice. There is no socializing before or after practice.
- Locker rooms and permanent restrooms will NOT be available.
- The Dolphins will provide a Porta Potty for EMERGENCY USE only. Please have your child use the bathroom before and after practice at HOME.
- Swimmers must have their own gear – caps, goggles, kickboards, and fins. We will have a limited number of kickboards and fins available on a loan program. There will be a \$25 deposit for either kickboard or fins that will be returned when the kickboard or fins are returned in the same condition they were given out in at the end of the season. Checks only. We recommend having a spare pair of goggles and cap for practice as no one will be able to loan out any equipment and coaches will not be able to cap swimmers.
- **Swimmers MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM across a 25-yard pool independently, without touching the bottom or hanging on to the gutters or lane lines.** Swimmer must also be able to pull themselves out of the water from both ends of the pool. Ladder use will not be permitted. We have very limited space and if your child CANNOT make the requirements there will not be a refund. We recommend if you are not sure to wait until the summer and participate in lessons or for summer season when we will hopefully be able to return to a more normal swim season.
- Parents will be required to stay outside of the gated area. If you are not comfortable with this policy, please do not sign up. While outside the gate you must practice social distancing among other families
- **Refunds**  
Due to the limited space, high cost of running a swim season during COVID-19, as well as the tight turnaround time, there are **NO REFUNDS/NO Cancellations to Spring 2021 registration/NO trial periods.** This refund policy supersedes the refund policy in our Dixon Dolphins Handbook. The only exception will be for swimmers who register and do not pass the swim assessment.
