## 2021 Assistant Coach Dress Code

Swim Meets: All Coaches should wear shorts and a Thousand Oaks Otters team shirt to all meets.

Practice: When wearing a swimsuit at practice, Coaches will be required wear a full coverage suit (similar to team suit coverage). No two-piece suits, white, light colored, or see-through suits are allowed.

### Code of Conduct

All Coaches are expected to behave in a professional manner while on deck or representing the Team and adhere to the following guidelines:

- Adhere to the USA Swimming Code of Conduct
- Arrive on time for all practices and meets
- Consistently display high standards of behavior and appearance
- Treat all swimmers, parents, coaches and board members with respect and dignity
- Treat all competitors and other conference team members with respect
- Observe the authority and decisions of the officials or board members and only question those decisions in the appropriate manner
- Use appropriate language. Use of profane or abusive language or obscene gestures will not be tolerated.
- No drinking of alcohol or use of tobacco products or illegal drugs or any substances banned by USA Swimming.
