- Your starter system as backup. Please ensure it is fully charged.
 - **As many officials as you can!** We will alternate referees and starters.
 - Stop watches (for your timers).
- Deck Area:** To maximize deck space families may set up chairs but no tents.
- Coaches Area:** An area will be available for coaches on the side of the pool closest to the Clerk of Course. Coaches may also erect a small canopy.
- Team Area:** All tents will be set up in the field next to the pool. Visitor set up is **not allowed** until the morning of the swim meet.
- Pool and FYI**
- The pool is 8 lanes, 25 meters long.
 - Backstroke Flags are Regulation of 16'5" (5 meters)
 - We will **not** be doing Fly-Over starts.
 - Please have swimmers and parents listen for the event numbers to be called so Clerk of Course runs smoothly.
