

Inclement Weather Conditions

TEGA CAY BREAKERS:

- ❑ In case of inclement weather, **do not assume a practice or meet has been cancelled.** If it is not thundering/lightening, we will swim!! Because the league's meet schedule does not always allow time for rescheduling rainouts, the meets will most likely go on as scheduled if it is only raining.
- ❑ Swimmers must be out of the water and in a safe refuge (a building or a vehicle) for a minimum of 30 minutes after the last audible sound of thunder or lightening.
- ❑ Please make sure you are signed up for text messages and we have your current email and check them for cancellations/delays of practices or meets.

METROLINA LEAGUE RULES:

- ❑ Heat lightening equals lightening. It will be treated with the same precaution as lightening which produces audible thunder.
- ❑ Swimmers must be out of the water and in a safe refuge (a building or a vehicle) for a minimum of 30 minutes after the last audible sound of thunder or lightening.
- ❑ If weather is threatening or conditions do not allow the start of a meet, the teams will wait a minimum of one hour from the meet start time to make a decision. At this time, the decision will be made based on time and weather patterns.
- ❑ If a meet is in progress and is suspended due to weather, the teams can agree to eliminate IM and breast events, in that order, in an effort to complete the meet.
- ❑ If the meet is in progress and suspended due to weather and the time is 8 p.m., the decision to complete the meet is up to the team coaches.
- ❑ A make-up meet may be scheduled based on approval from all coaches involved and approval from the respective neighborhood pool for usage of the facility. Pool location may be changed based on approval of all coaches involved, with preference given to the host of the cancelled meet.
