Code of Conduct
2018 Season

As a member of the Cheshire Forest Flying Fish Swim Team,
I, _____, (print name of
participant), agree to the following rules and regulations:

1. I understand that the coaches are responsible for the safety on the pool deck and I will listen to their instructions WITHOUT QUESTION.
2. There is no running, no diving (unless instructed to do so by the coaches), no pushing and/or horseplay while at practice, meets or official swim team functions.
3. No foul language will be tolerated at any time.
4. I will be respectful of all individuals to include coaches, parents, and swimmers of our team as well as any opposing team.
5. I will be respectful of myself, behaving appropriately as a member and representative of the Cheshire Forest swim team, at home and away meets, and at any team functions.
6. I will arrive on time and be ready to swim for all practices that I attend.
7. I will remain outside the gates of the pool until my scheduled practice time. I will leave the pool deck and exit the gates immediately upon conclusion of practice.
8. I realize that I am responsible for signing the attendance book as well as communicating to the coaches meet availability.
9. I must attend a minimum of 3 practices in order to be eligible to swim in the meet for that week. (Exceptions can be made on an individual basis if communicated to the coach.)

If the swimmer does not abide by the above stated rules, the following actions will be taken:

1. First offense: swimmer will be removed from the situation and will be informed of the rule broken/ behavioral incident and if both parties can come to agreement swimmer may return to practice. A call to parent/guardian will follow. Incident will be documented.
2. Second offense: swimmer will be removed as stated above, but will be asked to leave practice, and a phone call will coincide. Incident will be documented.
3. Third Offense: swimmer will be removed, as stated above, and will not be allowed to continue practice for that week, nor will he/she be able to participate in the upcoming swim meet. Incident will be documented.

A weekly meeting of coaches and team representatives will review behavioral issues from the previous week and discuss if further actions and/ or communication are required.

4. If at this point it is decided that the behavior in question cannot be rectified, the following actions will be taken:
 - a. Swimmer will be removed from the official roster of the swim team.
 - b. A prorated refund will be given for the registration fee paid for that season. You will forfeit all apparel costs and concession donations made to that point.
 - c. Your swimmer will not be allowed to attend as guest or otherwise any official swim team function unless accompanied and supervised by parent or guardian at all times.

I have read the above rules and regulations and am willing to abide by them. A copy of this document will be on file with the team representative(s).
