I understand & agree to the following in order for my child(ren) to participate on the Cheshire Forest Flying Fish swim team:

1. Swimmer must be a Cheshire Forest resident (at least part time) in order to participate on the swim team.
2. Swimmer must be able to swim the length of the pool unassisted.
3. **At least one parent must volunteer for meets; both may be needed at times.**
4. Swim suits must be appropriate for swim practice.

5. Insurance: Cheshire Forest HOA and the Cheshire Forest Swim Team does not provide or offer Accident Insurance for the swim team. It is the parent's responsibility to secure insurance.
6. Swimmers must follow all social distancing guidelines set forth by the team and HOA. Failure to follow the rules will result in the swimmer being sent home. If a swimmer has to be sent home a third time, they will no longer be able to participate with the team this summer.
7. By signing this consent, parents are notified that the Cheshire Forest HOA, the Cheshire Forest Swim Team and its volunteers are not responsible in case of accident, injury or illness while practicing or competing in a Swim Team event.
8. All swimmers must abide by all Cheshire Forest HOA pool rules and regulations.

Code of Conduct
2020 Season**

As a member of the Cheshire Forest Flying Fish Swim Team,

I, _____, (print name of each participant in
your family) and _____ (name of parent/guardian) agree to the following:

1. I/We will not come to practice or swim activity if I, or anyone in my home, has a fever or chills, shortness of breath, cough, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea, sudden loss of taste or smell. Or if in the last 14 days you, or someone in your home had contact with a known COVID-19 patient without PPE or travelled to a high-risk country or area within the U.S., or been advised to self-quarantine by medical or government authorities.
2. I/We will follow all safe distancing guidelines and wear my mask if I am not in a swim lane. If I do not follow the safe distancing guidelines, or will not wear my mask, I understand I will be sent home. If I am sent home three times, I will not be able to continue with the swim team the summer of 2021.
3. I/We understand that the coaches are responsible for the safety on the pool deck and I will listen to their instructions WITHOUT QUESTION.
4. There is no running, no diving (unless instructed to do so by the coaches), no pushing and/or horseplay while at practice, meets or official swim team functions.
5. No foul language will be tolerated at any time.
6. I/We will be respectful of all individuals to include coaches, parents, and swimmers of our team as well as any opposing team.
7. I/We will be respectful of myself, behaving appropriately as a member and representative of the Cheshire Forest swim team, at meets, and at any team functions.
8. I/We will arrive on time and be ready to swim for all practices that I attend.
9. I/We will remain outside the gates of the pool until my scheduled practice time. I will leave the pool deck and exit the gates immediately upon conclusion of practice.

If the swimmer does not abide by the above stated rules, the following actions may be taken:

1. The child will be sent home. A call to parent/guardian will follow.
2. If an incident happens a second time, the child will be sent home again and their parent/guardian will be called.
3. In the unusual case of a swimmer not following the rules a third time, they will be sent home and not allowed to participate in further 2020 swim activities.

I have read the above rules and regulations and am willing to abide by them.
