Weekly Notes from Coach Jay; my observations from the Statistics	We outnumbered them, but we were strongest in 10 & Unders events. We did well in most events, but surprisingly, we were heavily outscored in Butterfly. We will be pulling out the fins this week and working on that a lot. They were very even in IM as well. And let's not talk about the number of DQ's. Coaches will be discussing each DQ with the Swimmers.		We seem very evenly matched this year with Cheshire. Pretty even, but we had the edge in Relay, Freestyle, Backstroke and 11 & Older Events. And of the 69 events, we took top spot in just over half of them. We had a fantastic percentage of Best Times this week! But we will be working on DQ's Monday at the Stroke Clinics. Please try to be there! We will look over the DQ's.		Let me explain something about the advantage other teams seem to have in % Best Times. I keep all our times from year to year. Other teams seem to think it easier to start from scratch week to week or year to year. They also, purposely do not enter times for import at meets. So if you look at the entries on Sat AM, when you see a lot of NT (no Times) entered for the other team, that is automatically a Best Time. Anyway, we seem to have done well, but our last minute changes in the relays hurt a bit, but we should have swimmers coming back this Friday.		Every year, Indian Lakes seems to out number us. Relay events are favored to the larger team. In 6 events, the Stingrays had 2 or 3 relays to our 1. The strongest 3 statistics for the Seahawks were the Breaststroke events, the 11 & older swimmers and lower number of DQ's. It is a DQ for kickboards, so DQ on stroke technique is getting better. The coaching staff was very happy with the results of our work on Breast & Butterfly. Also, 43% of the team had 2 or more Best Times swimming at night! Wait for Divisionals!!
