



Walkill Valley Swim Conference

2021 Virtual Championships

In response to the ongoing pandemic and concerns regarding the volume of people that gather for a traditional championship meet, the Walkill Valley Swim Conference has decided to hold this event virtually this year. Teams will hold this event independently (their team only) and submit their results to the league to be merged with all of the other teams results in the league. For the sake of fairness and consistency, teams may not agree to host other teams for this event. Teams are welcomed to come up with ways to make this fun for their kids with special heat winner awards, special "Hot" heats, etc. The WVSC plans to return to its traditional in-person event next season.

Dates: Wednesday 7/28-Saturday 7/31. In order to give our member teams as much flexibility as possible in securing their facility and running this event, teams may run their championship meet at any time during this window. Teams may hold their own timeframe for that day depending on their team's needs.

Swimmer Eligibility: must meet the following criteria to qualify for Championships:

1. Must have swum in 50% or more of their team's meets (this has been relaxed to a minimum of two meets this season).
2. Must have earned a cut-off time at any WVSC-sanctioned meet during the current season to be eligible for that event in Championships. Times from other leagues do not count.

Events & Meet File: The same events as listed in the WVSC Rules & Regulations. A Hy-Tek Meet file (mdb) will be provided by the league. This is the file that teams will run the meet with; it will have to be modified for each team's site (yards or meters? 5 lanes or 6?). After modifying, an Events file can be created for TM to be used for entries, much the same way we do for dual meets. Note: if a window pops up when exporting the Events file, check the following to allow converted times to be accepted:



Coaches Tip: Want an easy way to see what swimmers have qualified? Once the meet events are imported into TM, go to Reports/Meet Reports/Meet Eligibility and check off "only eligible swimmers" to print out a spreadsheet. Make sure to run each time you add new results to your system.

Time Standards: Due to some teams competing in a SCY and some competing in LCM, teams should use the time standards associated with their facilities' course. All entry times must have been achieved at WVSC meets (not Club, YMCA, etc.) during this season, verified by Proof of Times report (easy directions to be provided).

Entries:

- Coaches create their entries as usual, but do not need to send them in prior to meet.
- Each swimmer may swim in a maximum of two individual events and 1 relay.
- Relays: There will be one all-boy and one all-girl 200 Step-up Medley Relay. A swimmer must have qualified for, and swum in, an individual event to be eligible to swim in the relay.
- Swimmers must swim in their respective age groups. "SWIMMING UP" is not permitted in either individual or relay events at Championships.
- 6 & Under swimmers score points in Championships, provided that they swim unassisted and without a lane swimmer.

Scoring: The same scoring as listed in the WVSC Rules & Regulations.

Awards: The league will assemble and deliver ribbons and medals to teams the week after.

Officials: Each team's meet shall be officiated by their own team's officials, in similar roles as in dual meets, with all times, DQs, etc. recorded in the provided meet file. There should be a minimum of two (non-athlete) timers per lane.

Records: Results from this virtual event will not be eligible for new WVSC Records.

Public Relations: Meet Results and Swim-A-Long information will be shared with local newspaper outlets around the county.

Results: Teams may submit their results as soon as their event is completed, but no later than 8:00 pm on 7/31/21. Please email the following to Alicia Berg, League Sec'y @ jillpey@gmail.com.

To Submit Results:

1. Meet Manager Merge of Same Meet (in MM, File/Export/Export Results Meet Manager Merge of Same Meet).
2. Backup of Meet (in MM, File/Backup).
3. Proof of Times (when entries are completed in TM, Reports/Meet Reports/Meet Entries and select "include proof of time" and sort by name).
4. An action photo or two to add to our PR packet?

All participating teams agree to abide by these terms. Any teams that do not adhere to the rules contained herein and within the WVSC Rules & Regulations will not have their results recognized. Please report any problems or anomalies, and thanks for everyone's cooperation as we all work through this together.

All Time Standards will be taken from the 15th Place Finals results from the previous season's Conference Championships; for events with less than 15 swimmers, times will remain unchanged. All conversions using Hy-Tek Team Manager's conversion factor of 1.11. Note: conversion times are not 100% compatible Swimmers must earn the time in the Championship Course of that season (swimmers must achieve the LC times listed above for LC Championships, for example).

↓- represents a faster time than previous season

↑- represents a slower time than previous season
