Our last meet which culminated Southern California's short course season was the **Junior Olympics** held in Pasadena CA at the Rose Bowl Aquatic Center. with over 1500 athletes, and over 100 teams, STAR placed 31st overall with a handful of swimmers and no relays. Our STAR team



performed some outstanding swimming and swam to many new times, placing in the top 20 for second swims every day.

Congratulations to Jaydah and Bo who were our high scorers.

Eden Addison (11-12) had a nice 2 sec drop in her 200 free and stayed on her time in the 100 back

Laina May (11-12) dropped a tinge in her 200 free and stayed on her 500 time

Natalia Ferrette (11-12) dropped a tinge in her 50 free time

Bo Vinyard (9-10) swam to a new JAG cut in her 50 back 34.10 placing 14th overall dropping -70.

She swam to a new 200 time medaling in her 200 free, placing 6th with a new time of 2:17.09. she dropped 1/2 a sec in her 100 free from 1:04.39 to 1:03.74. Dropping a tinge in the 100 back gave her 14th in the consolation bracket. And her 500 was an outstanding 3rd place overall swimming to a 5:57.71. Overall Bo had to swim 9 events total with prelims and finals.

Jaydah Godbolt (9-10) had a stellar swim meet. She had 11 overall events including prelim and final swims. She place 2nd in the 500 with a time of 5:55.60; 3rd in 50 free with a sizzling time of 27.63 (-1.14 drop); 5th in 50 back 32.62; 5th in 100 free with a time of 1:01.83(-.21); 2nd in 100 back 1:08.82 (-1.42); and 11th winning the consolation bracket in the 100 IM and setting a new team record 1:10.71 with a time improvement of -1.85.
