CONDITION OF SANCTION

TAC Titans COVID-19 MEET PLAN

NCS FACE COVERING STATEMENT

NCS recommends the proper use of face coverings at all NCS activities and expects all participants, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators to comply with all club and facility specific COVID-19 safety requirements and guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, the State of North Carolina, and local jurisdictions.

FACILITY and HOST TEAM REQUIREMENTS

The TAC TITANS have discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management. As of the date of this sanction request, TAC requires that all patrons - participants, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators - wear face masks inside the facility, regardless of vaccination status. Compliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

PARENTAL ACCESS

Parents needing access to their athlete during the meet in a closed-deck environment can contact their children directly via cellphone and arrange to meet the Front Desk. Should parents be unable to contact their child directly, they should see the Meet Marshal located at the deck entrance in the Lower lobby. In the case of an emergency, please call and/or text the Facility Director at 919.459.4045.

FACILITY

The Triangle Aquatic Center (TAC) provides 3 indoor pools and supporting amenities including a Spectator Stadium and Atrium with capacity of up to 2000, full-service café, performance recovery center, hospitality gallery, classroom and wireless internet. Select swim gear can be purchased from the front desk.

The 50-meter competition pool with bulkhead offers a total of 8 50-meter competition lanes with a depth of 7 to 12 feet that can be configured for separate 8-lane and 10-lane, 25-yard competition courses. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). A copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming, Inc. Paddock Starting Blocks with Swim Innovation decks complete with Foot Wedge and optional non-mechanical backstroke ledges (at the meet referee's discretion) are available for all competition lanes. The competition lanes are a minimum of 7 feet wide. The 25-yard program pool allows for up to ten (10) warm-up/warm-down lanes at any time. There is a Daktronics OmniSport 2000 Pro Swimming timing system with HD video scoreboard.

The separate warm water instruction pool is fully enclosed and remains open to the public during meet competitions. The facility may charge a fee for admission to spectators. Meet participant parking is available across from the swimmer drop-off loop and in the shopping mall lot adjacent to the pool. Illegally parked vehicles are liable to be ticketed or towed by the local Police Department and the owner's expense.

Per USA Swimming and Safe Sport Rules...ONLY USA Swimming registered athletes, current USA Swimming registered officials and coaches may be on deck during warm-ups and/or competition. ALL coaches, officials and meet personnel will be required to wear wristbands or lanyards on the pool deck. Please check-in at the clerk of course.

- MONDAY MORNING ONLY

*ALL 12 & UNDER EVENTS, ALL DISTANCE EVENTS (≥ 400 yards) and ALL RELAYS are timed finals events. All other events will be conducted on a prelims/finals basis.

*All events on Friday evening will be PRE-SEEDED and swim SLOW to FAST.

*The number of heats for ALL DISTANCE EVENTS (≥ 400 yards) may be limited to stay within the required 4-hour session timeline limit.

*All 13 & OVER RELAYS will swim in the evening FINALS. There is no AM/PM option.

*The 13 & OVER 1000 FREE will be DECK-SEEDED and swim FAST to SLOW.

*The number of heats for the 13 & OVER 1000 FREE may be limited to the top 32 qualifiers of each gender. Three heats will swim in the morning prelims and one heat will swim in Sunday evening finals. TIMES MUST BE PROVABLE. LC times are allowed but will be seeded last in rank order. There will be an AM/PM option.

SWIMMERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A PERSON TO COUNT LAPS FOR THE 500 FREE AND THE 1000 FREE.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated

TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

MAAPP

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

SAFE SPORT

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer’s team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is

prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc., prior to the entry deadline and all Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **THERE WILL BE NO ON DECK REGISTRATION AVAILABLE AT THIS MEET.**

TIME STANDARDS

There are no time standards for this meet

MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

The TAC Titans welcome all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit The TAC Titans' ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

As an invitational meet, teams **MUST** contact the Meet Director as soon as possible and **NO LATER THAN** Friday, Dec 24, 2021 to express their interest in attending. Otherwise, acceptance of entries cannot be guaranteed. The meet will be capped at 1,100 swimmers.

ENTRIES will not be accepted before Friday, Dec 24, 2021 at 8:00 AM and not after Wednesday, Jan 5, 2022 at 8:00 PM. Please **DO NOT** send entries if you have not previously contacted the Meet Director.

"NT" entry times **WILL NOT** be accepted at this meet.

Entries should be submitted in Hy-Tek format via email. A completed and signed "Summary of Fees" Sheet (included in this announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator before the start of the meet. Swimmers will not be allowed to swim until all fees are paid. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.

All relay only swimmers including alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund and Facility Surcharge.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Individual events: Swimmers may swim 2 individual events on Friday and 3 individual events plus 1 relay per day on Saturday and Sunday. Swimmers are limited to 8 individual events for the meet (not including time trials).

11&O may swim a maximum of 4 (four) time trials on Monday. This does not count towards the limit for the meet.

Relays:

Teams are limited to three (3) relay teams per relay event (A, B, & C ONLY).

RELAYS WILL ONLY BE SWUM IF THE TIMELINE PERMITS.

ENTRY VERIFICATION An email will be sent to the person submitting the entries confirming receipt within 48 hours.

ENTRY DEADLINES The Meet Entry Coordinator MUST receive entries no later than WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 5, 2022 at 8:00 PM. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director but will be charged the Late Entry Fee of double the individual event fee. There will be NO ON DECK ENTRIES OR CHANGES ACCEPTED.

SEEDING The conforming time standard for this meet is short-course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swum slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.

CHECK-IN All events will be pre-seeded with the exception of the 1000 Freestyle. Check-in deadline for the 1000 Freestyle is Saturday at 8:00PM.

SCRATCHES The current NCS Scratch Rule will be in effect during the course of this meet for prelims/finals and deck seeded events (see attachment). This will serve as the official guide for technical procedural rules, except when stated otherwise in the Meet Announcement. Coaches and swimmers are expected to be familiar with the rule.
ALL SWIMMERS SHOULD SCRATCH FROM SUNDAY FINALS IF THEY HAVE NO INTENTION OF SWIMMING.

SCORING This meet will not be scored.

AWARDS Heat prizes will be awarded at this meet for 12&Under swimmers.

RESULTS Results will be posted on the Triangle Aquatic Center website <http://www.triangleaquatics.org/events/event-results/> within 48 hours of the meet's conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-Tek backups either via email attachment or on www.ncswim.org.

COACHES

All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming.

Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

PLEASE EMAIL THE MEET DIRECTOR A LIST OF ALL COACHES WHO WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE NO LATER THAN THE MONDAY BEFORE THE MEET STARTS.

NCS Registration Chair will provide meet management with a list of current coaches' certifications. Coaches who are not current in all required certifications will not be allowed on deck.

**OFFICIALS/TIMERS/
VOLUNTEERS**

All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of such to the meet referee by displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A certification card showing the official's level of certification must also be presented. Officials who would like to work at the meet should contact the meet referee prior to the meet.

**HOSPITALITY/
CONCESSIONS**

TAC is proud to offer hospitality to all coaches and officials participating in the corresponding session of the meet. Hospitality is offered prior to and into the corresponding session, not after. TAC will also provide snacks and drinks on deck to coaches, officials and meet personnel.

WARM-UP

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures.

Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/warm-down. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

WAIVER/RELEASE

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. The TITANS, Triangle Aquatic Center, North Carolina Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all our team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.

IMAGE RELEASE

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or NCS website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.

TIME TRIALS

Time Trials for 11&Over Swimmers will be offered on Monday morning. All strokes of 50s, 100s, 200s, 200/400 IM, and 500 Free will be offered.

PLEASE NOTE:

A swimmer **MUST** be pre-registered in at least one event during the meet (Friday – Sunday) to swim a Time Trial.

Swimmers are eligible to swim a maximum of 4 Time Trials.

Time Trial entry fees are \$10.00 per event and payable in cash to the Admin Referee.

Sign-ups at the Clerk of Course table will begin on Friday at 5:30pm and end on Sunday at 6:30pm.

Events and heats may be limited and/or combined at the Meet Referee's Discretion.

208.3. INDIVIDUAL SCRATCH RULE - Swimmers shall inform themselves of the meet starting time and shall report to the proper meet authorities promptly upon call. The meet announcement shall specify all mandatory check-in and scratch deadlines and procedures.

.1 Pre-Seeded Meets - Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized.

.2 Events Seeded on the Deck - Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded on the deck, in whole or in part, who has checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the clerk of course before the seeding for that event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch or as noted in 208.3.4 A or D.. Failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in the swimmer being barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer entered in the meet. Unless the meet announcement states otherwise, events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event except that individual events of 400 meters or longer may be closed for seeding up to twenty four (24) hours before the expected start of the event if the check-in/scratch deadline occurs after the beginning of the meet and is announced in the meet announcement.

.3 Preliminary and Finals Events

A. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in a pre-seeded preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized. If the preliminary heat is seeded on the deck, then 208.3.2 applies

B. Any swimmer qualifying for an A final, scored or not scored, or B scored final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said A or B final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet, except as noted in 208.3.4. A declared false start or deliberate delay of meet is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.

C. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, when possible, the Referee shall fill the A, B, or C final with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These and all other alternates and those qualifying for non-scoring B or C finals shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete

D. When the B or C final has not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known in advance by the Referee, the Referee should re-seed the A, B, or C finals, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final. In order to prevent undue delay of the A, B, or C finals, the Referee may elect to fill the empty lane(s), without re-seeding, with the next qualified alternate, or if unavailable, the next qualified swimmer(s) who is/are present in the starting area and ready to swim

E. If a C or B final has already been swum, the A final of that event shall be swum without filling the empty lane(s)

.4 Exception for Failure to Compete - No penalty shall apply for failure to compete in or scratch an individual event if:

A. The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.

B. The swimmers qualifying for an A final or B final race based upon the results of the preliminaries notifies the Referee within thirty (30) minutes after announcement of the qualifiers of that final race that they may not intend to compete and also declares his final decision whether or not to scratch within thirty (30) minutes following his last individual preliminary heat, swim-off, or re-swim.

C. The swimmer was not named in any finals heat during the initial announcement of results

D. It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

208.4. RELAY SCRATCH RULE
