Beginning September 1, 2016

How to Register:

1. Register with US Masters Swimming here: <https://www.usms.org/reg/register.php>
2. Bring a copy to practice or email them to: coachbarry@brookingswimclub.com
3. Bring a check for \$50 for your 12 practices. We will keep track of usage. Once the 12 have been used, you need to purchase an addition 12 practices for \$50, etc. Make payment to Brookings Swim Club.

Where are practices held? Brookings High School 530 Elm Ave. (enter through South entrance)

When are practices offered? September 12, 2016 to May 26, 2017 Monday, Wednesday, Friday 5:45-6:55am
May 31 to August 3, 2017: Monday & Thursday 6:00-7:00am

Practice Time Changes: There will be some days where practices are cancelled due to swim meets/coach travel, holidays, or club breaks from swimming. If school is cancelled due to weather practices are also cancelled. There are a couple of ways to see updated practices:

- 1) Go to Brookings Swim Club homepage and click the Calendar tab at top of page;
In this window, there is a 'Pick a Calendar' box... click this and click Masters;
You can look at each month's practice schedule, but check every 1-2 weeks for updates.
- 2) At bottom of our home page you'll see a 'News' section. Each weekend there will be a post listed as 'Weekly Notes for ***'. Click that weekends news to see any practice announcements for the upcoming week.

Cost to Participate: US Masters Yearly Registration Fee of \$44 (paid through USMS portal. Plus, the \$50 for every 12 'attended' practices. You are only charged for practices attended.
