Covid-19 Phase 2 Swim Teams

We would like to welcome back the swim teams in this part of our phased reopening. We appreciate your patience during our process. At times it may seem like an extremely slow process, but the symptoms of Covid-19 usually take a good period of time to manifest. We have only been open for three weeks, now. We will continue to monitor our local area and make adjustments as we progress. Please bear in mind that the reopening phases are not solely based on what the governor recommends, but also on what we can do with our current resources of staff and budgets.

As we move into Phase 2 beginning June 15, we will begin to reintroduce swim team practices. We will still have no locker room access for showering and changing, but have a few additional procedures for swim teams.

1. All swimmers and coaches must follow our Covid-19 guidelines, including not coming on site if you feel sick or have been around someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19, maintaining at least 6' apart from others when not actively swimming, and are strongly encouraged to wear cloth face masks when not in the water.
2. All teams will enter from the double gate between the new pool and new pavilion area. A KAC team member will open the gate at a designated time (decided in advance between the KAC Director and the Team Point of Contact). The swimmers will then proceed to the double doors between concession window and the stairs to the spectator balcony.
3. Teams who are bringing in groups at different times need to ensure a 10 minute buffer between groups to minimize any overcrowding of space. Failure to do so may result in reduction of lane space allocated.
4. No more than 10 swimmers allowed in any lane.
5. Any equipment brought inside must be kept neat and orderly on the deck. Please minimize the amount of equipment brought inside.
6. No spectators allowed inside. Parents must remain outside in their cars or can drop off and pick up swimmers near the outdoor waterpark entrance who are under the guardianship of a certified coach. There can be no blocking of the double gate/ delivery area.
7. Upon the end of practice, swimmers need to promptly exit the same way that they came in.
