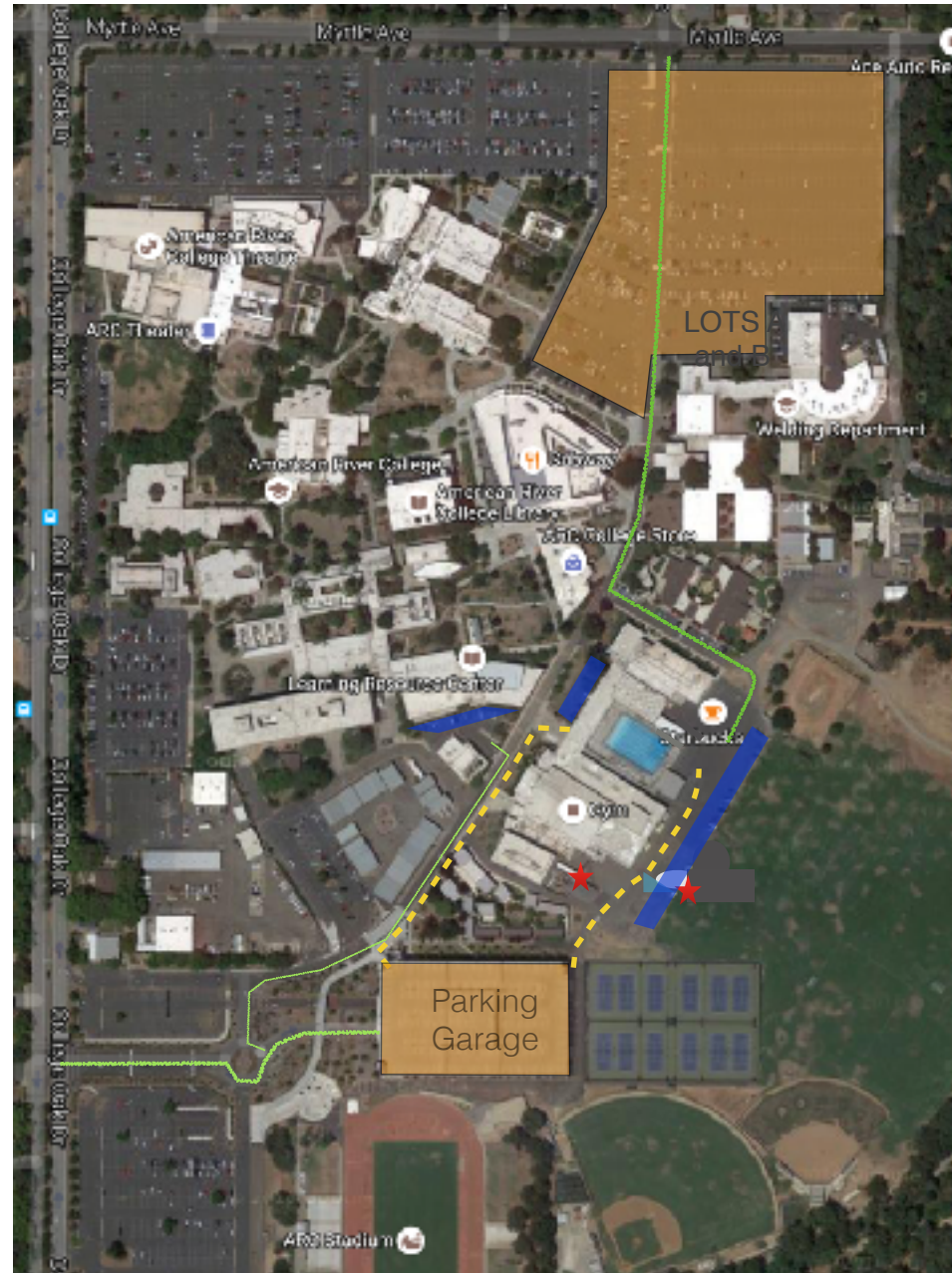

- To **access the drop off area** of the pool, enter campus by Myrtle Ave into Lot A/B. Head toward the pool and turn left at the drive just before the street barricade. You will be able to drive to the back to drop off, but not to park.
- When possible, leave yourself **extra time for parking**. The parking garage is a short walk to the pool from the exit on the 'back' side of the structure (near the tennis courts.) Lots A or B are also good options.
- In the **early mornings** you may use the area in front of the pool to drop off. If you are planing to stay in your vehicle, you could consider using the 'staff' spots since we leave before most staff arrive. However, if you leave you risk getting a ticket. There will soon be plenty of 'staff' spots in the back of the pool once the soccer fields are opened. (Blue area)

Please remember... **NO SWIMMER SHOULD LEAVE PRACTICE ALONE!**

- Senior swimmers driving themselves will be coordinating a parking location so that they can walk in groups to and from the pool. (For now it is the Parking Garage). Park with the group!



Visitor Parking

A visitor parking area with parking meters is located by the Administration Building on College Oak Drive. The cost is 25¢ per 15 minutes. No student parking is permitted in the visitors area.

Semester or Daily Parking Permits

All vehicles on campus 7:00 a.m.–11:00 p.m. must display a semester permit or daily parking permit. Student Permits are not required during non-school days and weekends. For your protection, all vehicles should be locked and all valuables stored out of sight.

- **Daily parking permits** are \$2 and are dispensed from machines located in student lots. In case of machine malfunction, you may:

- 1) Purchase a permit from another machine;
- 2) Contact a college police office for a one-day permit. Notes about machine malfunction will not be accepted.

- **Semester permits.** A parking permit is \$35 per semester/\$20 for summer session. A permit entitles the student to day or evening college parking, and is available from the Business Services Office located in the Administration Building. Remember that a parking permit does not guarantee a parking space. A parking permit entitles you to park on campus where and when space is available, in student lots and/or the parking structure.

Handicapped Parking

Automobiles of students with disabilities (and persons providing transportation services to students with disabilities) must display a semester or daily parking permit as do other students. However, special parking spaces for disabled students are provided in all student & staff parking lots. A placard issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles for persons with disabilities, or a distinguishing license plate for persons with disabilities, must be properly displayed on the vehicle. Temporary disability permits are available from the Health Center; if you are issued a temporary permit you must also display a valid semester or daily parking permit.

Tow-Away

Vehicles parked illegally in red zones and vehicles parked so as to impede the flow of traffic on campus streets, lot entrances and driveways, in front of fire hydrants or in other areas where emergency vehicles might be hindered, may be subject to being towed away at owner's expense and inconvenience. Vehicles parked in staff or handicapped spaces are subject to tow-away
