This position would report directly to the CCA Head Coach/CEO. We are looking for a coach who loves the local swimming community and will provide a FUN environment and positive swim team culture!

Position will start in early March. Workouts will be held at the Roseville Aquatics Complex (3051 Woodcreek Oaks Dr, Roseville).

Preferred experience is 3+ years of coaching with experience in a leadership position and strong communicative skills. The coach is also required to become USA Swimming Certified (CCA will help with cost). This is a Part-Time hourly position. Further job details may be found below.

Lead Coach: Training Group (4x 1.25 hours a week Mon-Thur, Occasional Meets)

- Extended Development of 12 y.o.+ athletes,
- Introduction to simple dryland
- Expectation of swimmers to establish CCA Base Skills (Body Line, DPS, UWT)
- Keep athletes in shape as they develop for other groups OR are involved in other activities (multi-sport/activity)
- Provide Group with general season plans and goals
- Prepare athletes to participate in HS Water Polo/Swimming

Administrative Expectations for Coach

- Prepare daily workouts ahead of time, based on season plan developed in conjunction with Head Coach.
- Work with staff to develop meet schedule and attend meets scheduled for group if needed.
