How to sign your swimmer up for a swim meet!



Two, there is a process of communication that needs to happen to assign coaches and officials if you swimmer attends a meet that our team is not attending. 1. Create an OME Swim Connection Account

- Navigate to omeswimconnection.com. Create an account.




2. Add your swimmer/s to your online account

- USA ID is typically 3 letters of first name, middle initial, and the first 4 letters of the last name. An example would be 071404MELGLEWI. If your child doesn't have a middle initial you will put an "*" (please make sure you enter your child's USA Swimming number and that it is entered correctly.)
- Our LSC is **Pacific Swimming** and our Club Code is **SRN**.
- Once you have an account you don't need to enter this information in anymore.

3. Finding the Meet

- Navigate to the "Enter Meets" tab and find the meet you would like to enter.
- Example: SRN Short Course C/B+



4. Enter the Meet

a. Click on online meet entry

b. Select the swimmer you wish to enter, click "enter"

c. Choose the events he/she wants to swim. ***If child has not swam an event before at a sanctioned meet, a time of NT appears (no time).



