Directions: From the east, take Oakland Park Blvd. to just west of Nob Hill Rd. Turn left after Safety Complex. From the south, take Nob Hill north to Oakland Park Blvd. Turn left on Oakland Park, and left again after the Safety Complex

Parking: Parking is free. Please do NOT park on the south side of Josh Lee Blvd; drivers will be towed from this residential area.

- Date & Time:** Friday, November 5, 2021: warm up at 5 pm; meet starts at 5:30 pm
- Pool/Timing:** Competition is in the Sunrise Civic Center Pool 50 meters x 25 yards heated outdoor pool. 8 short-course racing lanes will be used. Separate warm-up and warm down lanes will be available. Daktronics Timing System® will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). Water depth at the start is at least 4'6" in accordance with 202.3.7 (C). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Camera Free Zone:** The Florida Gold Coast Swimming **CAMERA FREE ZONE** policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.
- Image Authorization:** All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.
- Conflict of Interest:** Unauthorized sale, advertisement and promotion of products and/or services at the location of the competition as well as its vicinities are not allowed without the written request and written approval of the meet host and meet director. All requests must be submitted to the meet director no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the competition. Failing to comply with such order will result in removal from the facility and/or immediate vicinity
- Rules:** Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee will be in effect.
- Public Health and Safety mandates and guidelines of the State of Florida, Broward County, City of Sunrise, Sunrise Civic Center, and Sunrise Swimming will be enforced.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
- Closed Deck:** Spectators will only be permitted in designated areas of the pool deck (south side of the pool), unless they are registered with USA Swimming as an athlete or as a non-athlete working the meet. The only exception is for timers and volunteers assisting with the conduct of the meet. Coaches will be permitted inside the roped-off areas of the pool deck provided they have shown proper credentials to the meet host and do not interfere with those conducting the meet.
- Deck Changes:** Changing, in part or whole, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is strictly prohibited.
- Eligibility:** Open to all current 2021 USA swimming athletes registered in Florida Gold Coast Swimming and affiliated with a Florida Gold Coast Swimming registered club.

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

The Meet Host **Will Not** be accepting new or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

- Disability Athletes:** Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted. - Entry Deadline:** All entries must be received by **Friday, October 29, 2021.**
- Entry Limit:** 4 Individual events and the relay
- Meet Cap:** The meet will be capped at **125 athletes** on a first come first served basis. This cap is subject to change depending on City capacity restrictions.
- Entry Procedure:** PLEASE enter electronically, NO MAILED entries. For electronic entries (CL or SDIF format only!!). E-mail to sunmeetentries@gmail.com. Email confirmation of entries will be sent to each team. Coaches are responsible for reviewing their team's entries at this time and notifying host of any issues within 24 hours.
- **Submission of electronic entries signifies that all swimmers are USA registered. Questions, please contact office at 954 747-4635
- NOTE: Swimmers who are not USA Swimming registered will not be entered.**
- Psych Sheet:** Once the psych sheet has been posted, no changes to the entries will be allowed unless it occurred due to an administrative error.
- Entry Fees:** \$15 flat fee per swimmer
- **Entry fees are made payable to Sunrise Swimming Booster Club**. Entry fees will be doubled if not entered electronically. (note: one check per team). Please bring check to meet or mail to PO BOX 450205, Sunrise, FL 33345**
- Deck Entries:** The FGC deck seed policy will NOT be in effect.
- Refunds:** Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed, there will be no refunds unless FGC rule 1.17a.i-v applies.
- Seeding:** Eligible entries shall be seeded Short course yards only, slowest to fastest.

Sunrise Swimming – COVID Plan – Fall 2021

In applying for this sanctioned event, the Host, Sunrise Swimming agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Florida Gold Coast Swimming, the State of Florida, City of Sunrise and Broward County.

Sunrise Swimming – Expectations for Swim Meet at Sunrise Civic Center:

BEFORE THE MEET

Before the meet, all swimmers, volunteers, and spectators are asked to read the meet information and any information provided regarding the operational procedures that will take place during the meet.

Any swimmer, volunteer, coach, parent, or staff should refrain from attending the meet if they are sick or experiencing any of the following COVID symptoms: fever or chills, cough, congestion or runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, chills, headache, muscle or body aches, fatigue, nausea, diarrhea, or vomiting, bright red or any rash.

DURING THE MEET

FACILITY ENTRY / EXIT: Spectators will enter the facility through the building (admission fee to be charged). Entrance to the building is either through the Rotunda area on the west side or the double doors on the east side.

Swimmers, coaches, and officials will enter the pool deck through the back east gate. This gate will be open for spectators to exit the pool deck, and for re-entry as long as they are wearing a wristband purchased when initially entering the pool deck.

FACILITY / DECK SET UP: We ask that all parents sit on the south side of the pool by the bleachers. NO tents allowed on the south side of the deck. Spectators can bring chairs and sit in designated areas. All teams (coaches and swimmers) will sit on the north side of the pool. No parents allowed on the north side of the pool.

The Bullpen for the Sizzlers will be on the north side of the pool deck.

Planned number of individuals for Sizzler: 125 swimmers, 16 timers, 20 volunteers, 2-3 coaches per team, spectators.

FACE MASKS: Are required inside the Sunrise Civic Center building. Rules may change and all teams will be notified if there are any changes to this rule.

SPECTATORS: Are allowed to sit on the south side of the pool deck. They will be separated from the swimmers and bullpen area.

BEFORE AND AFTER RACES:

Once the swimmer finishes their race, they will exit the pool and then walk around to the north side of the pool to get ready for their next race.

LOCKER ROOMS: Will be open. We ask that families use discretion in changing and showering after the meet.

CONCESSIONS: The Civic Center building is open to patrons. Concessions will be available at the meet.

HAND SANITATION STATIONS: Will be available throughout the facility during the course of the meet. Swimmers and spectators are encouraged to use them.

TRASH: Will be available throughout the facility.
