Location: **The College of the Florida Keys Pool, 5901 College Road, Key West**

Directions: Turnpike Extension to US1 south to MM5.5. Look for Sign that Reads: The College of the Florida Keys- Turn right on College Road. Take first Right into The College of the Florida Keys campus. Once on the campus, go left toward Tennessee Williams Fine Art Center. Turn right to back of campus. At stop sign, turn left and park. The Pool is located just beyond the Hyperbaric Chamber Building.

Date & Time: **Session Date: Saturday, September 5, 2020**
Session I - Timed Finals - Warm-up at 7:30 am. Meet starts at 9:00 am

***Meet director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop some events in order to hold an efficient meet within USA Swimming/FGC guidelines and with Age Group Chair approval.**

Pool/Timing: 25 yards x 20 yards heated outdoor pool, 8 **short-course** racing lanes with time available between events for warm-up/cool down. Colorado Timing System® will be used. Fly-over starts will possibly be used.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). Water depth at the start varies from 8’6” to 9’0” depending on lane assignment accordance with 202.3.7 (C).

Camera Free: The Florida Gold Coast Swimming **CAMERA FREE ZONE** policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

Image Authorization: All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and networks(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.

Conflict of Interest: Unauthorized sale, advertisement and promotion of products and/or services at the location of the competition as well as its vicinities are not allowed without the written request and written approval of the meet host and meet director. All requests must be submitted to the meet director no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the competition. Failing to comply with such order will result in removal from the facility and/or immediate vicinity.

Rules: 2020 USA Swimming and FGC rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee, will be in effect.

All Applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited on The College of the Florida Keys campus.

Deck Changes: Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room, or other space designated for changing purpose is prohibited.

Eligibility: Open to all current 2020 USA swimming registered athletes and foreign athletes with proper travel credentials who have been invited by USA Swimming.

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

The Meet Host **WILL** be accepting New or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

Disability Athletes: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, as to the need for any special

Entries: All entries must be received by **Tuesday, September 1, 2020.**

PLEASE enter electronically, NO MAILED entries. For electronic entries (CL or SDIF format only!!)

Confirmation for electronic entries will be sent via e-mail.

**Submission of electronic entries signifies that all swimmers are USA Registered. Questions, please contact office at 305-809-3562.

Note: **Swimmers without registration numbers or birth dates will not be entered.**

***** Entry Fees will be Double if not entered electronically.**

Entry Limit: **Individual events: Five (5) individual events per day**

Meet Cap: The meet will be capped at 100 athletes on a first comes first basis.

Deck Entries: THE FGC DECK SEED POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT. Deck entries permitted into open lanes only on a first-come-first-serve basis. Deadline for deck entries is 30 min. before start of meet. Policy can be seen at www.fgcswim.org. All deck entered swimmers must present proof of current USA Swimming registration in order to be entered.

Entry Fees: \$ 5.00 per individual event

Facility Surcharge: \$ 8.00 per swimmer

***Entry fees are made payable to The College of the Florida Keys.**

Unregistered Teams: Non-registered or nonexistent teams must submit entries for swim meets by e-mail with the information about the athletes (date of birth, name, USA-S ID#, events and entry times). **The entries are considered deck entries since they have to be entered manually and they will be charged accordingly**, which currently is double the stated amount in the meet announcement.

Refunds: Once the team or individual entry has been received and processed, there will be no refunds, unless FGC rule 1.17a.i.v applies.

Seeding: Use SCY times only for entries. **There will be a 10 minute break after the following events: 8, 16, 24, 32. Seeding SLOWEST TO FASTEST.**

Awards: Individual Events: Medals places: 1st—3rd. Ribbons places: 4th – 16th
In the following age group categories: 6 & U, 7, 8, 9, 10,11,12,13, 14, 15, 16 and 17& O

Scoring: Individual High Point trophy awarded for Top 3 in each Single Age group

Admission: Admission - \$2.00 per session. Heat Sheets - \$2.00 per session.

Warm-up Procedures: NO Equipment Permitted. Swimmers must enter the water feet first.
7:30 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. General Warm Up ; Swimming and Pulling Only, Push Off; No Racing Starts; No Sprinting or Pace Work
8:20 a.m. – 8:45 a.m. Controlled Warm Up
Lane 1 Pace, 50 and 100 Circle Swim, Push Off
Lane 2 Racing Starts, 25 yards One Length.
Lane 3 Swimming and Pulling, Push Off
Lane 4 Swimming and Pulling, Push Off
Lane 5 Swimming and Pulling, Push Off
Lane 6 Swimming and Pulling, Push Off
Lane 7 Racing Starts, 25 yards One Length
Lane 8 Pace, 50 and 100 Circle Swim, Push Off

1. Pace lanes – last 25 minutes of warm up. Push- off one or two lengths, circle swimming only (counter - clockwise), NO DIVING, feet first entries only.
2. Practice Racing Starts – Last 25 Minutes of warm-ups. Number of lanes as needed. Swimmers must exit the pool at the far end or return to the start end via a general warm-up lane. Do NOT return via the pace lanes.
3. General Lanes - Circle swimming only (counter clockwise only).

NOTE: Meet management reserves the right to adjust start time, times of session to ensure an efficient meet.
