"In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Florida Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."

Conditions of Sanction:

- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA-S Vice President of Program Operations.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

COVID-19: In applying for this sanction, SITE HOST agrees to comply and enforce all health and safety guidelines of USA Swimming, Florida Swimming and the city of the event.

A-Finals, B-Finals, and C-Bonus Finals – Senior Events

A-Finals, B-Finals – 15-16 year old Events

All age groups will swim combined in preliminary events and will be broken out by age group for finals events.

In the Finals Sessions, the order of events shall be A Final, B Final, C Final, if applicable (Fast to Slow). The C Final is limited to those athletes 18 years and younger.

****Preliminary sessions may be combined or separated. The final decision regarding order of events will be made by Senior Chair, meet hosts, and meet referee following the close of entries.****

Flyover and/or Chase starts may be used at the discretion of the meet referee. No changes in meet operation will occur without concurrence of the Sr. Chair & Committee. Warm up assignments will be made by Sr. Chair or designee if needed.

Distance Events:

Swimmers may swim the 800 free if they have the 1500 cut or they may swim the 1500 if they have the 800 cut.

Thursday night events will be the 800 free for Men and Women. Meet management has the option of alternating Women and Men and fighting if it is necessary by swimming 4 F/M heats then starting relays.

In the event of fighting, 400's and above will also be consolidated and swam fast to slow while possibly alternating women and men. The fastest four heats of each swimming in session 1.

Sunday will be the 1500 for Men and Women and will be consolidated by gender. The fastest two heats 1 M/F of 1500 will be swum at the beginning finals. Check in deadline for 1500 will be 8:15 AM Sunday.

Spectator Access:

Adopted by USA-Swimming, Florida Swimming, and YMCA of the USA, MAAPP (Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy) requires policies and standards to be used by athletes, adults, teams and facilities that are involved in the sport of swimming. These changes are mandated by USA-Swimming and the U.S. Center for Safe Sport and is a condition of the sanction of this meet.

Facilities with multiple restrooms/locker rooms must designate ONE set of restrooms/locker rooms for athletes under the age of 18 and a SEPARATE restroom/locker room for all meet attendees 18 and older.

This meet will operate with a closed pool deck per USA Swimming and Safe Sport guidelines. This means only swimmers, coaches, officials and assigned meet volunteers will be allowed inside the designated competition course for any given session. This rule is in place for both the safety of our swimmers and the efficiency of our meet operations.

Warm-up:

TBD - warmups will be determined based on entries for each site. One hour and fifteen (15) minutes will be guaranteed.

Pace lanes will be maintained during the 400, 800, and 1500 races

Eligibility:

Open to all currently registered 2021 Florida Swimming swimmers who have achieved the current Senior Championship time standard as listed between July 22, 2018 and July 14th, 2021, the meet entry deadline.

No conversions of times are acceptable. Late entries will be permitted as stated in meet letter.

Disability Swimming:

Florida Swimming encourages the participation of USA Swimming members with disabilities in this meet. The swimmer's disability must meet the definition of a disability as outlined in USA-Swimming Rules and Regulations: "A permanent physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities." Swimmers with disabilities may compete, earn awards, and score points for their team in the same manner as able-bodied swimmers. Such swimmers need not have achieved the included qualifying times for this meet. Entries for swimmers with disabilities should be submitted via OME, with an e-mail to: admin@floridaswimming.org. The coach or athletes are responsible for notifying the Referee of any accommodations that are required in accordance with USA-Swimming Rule 105.4.

Any athlete with a disability will be accommodated to the best of meet management's ability. Please contact the Meet Director at least two weeks prior to the start of the event to allow for preparation.

Entry Limit:

Total of six (6) individual events for the meet, but no more than three (3) per day, plus relays. Teams may enter a maximum of two (2) relay teams per event and they must be designated "A" and "B". Over-entries will be automatically dropped when the limit is met for the meet and/or day.

Bonus Events:

The "Bonus Event" Rule will be in effect for this meet. The formula is as follows: Swimmers qualified in one or more events may swim up to two (2) bonus events during the course of this meet, subject to the meet rules on limitations on number of swims and qualifying bonus standards must be met. Each bonus swim entered must be a provable time. NT entries will not be accepted. In the OME system, select "Enter as Bonus" to enter bonus events. No Bonus Events for 800 and 1500.

Note: There will be a scratch box for swimmers/coaches to declare scratches, located at the Clerk of Course Table.

Courtesy Check-In – Available until 5:30 p.m. the night prior to the event.

FINES Late entries will be accepted up to 24 hours of OME closing and will be charged a \$100 processing + 2x the entry fee.

Clubs with swimmers that fail to swim in Finals on Sunday night without Scratching will incur a \$100 club fine per event.

Scratch Penalty: Preliminary and Timed Final events:

No penalty for scratching on the blocks in prelims with the exception of deck seeded events. Swimmers entered and checked in for a deck seeded event must swim that event unless he/she notifies the clerk of course, before seeding begins, that he/she wishes to scratch that event. Failure to do so will result in the swimmer being barred from his/her next individual event on that day or the next, whichever is first. Deck seeded events shall be closed for seeding as listed on the order of events.

1. Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies as one of the original 16 or 24 finalists as announced must swim in that final's event; or must notify the clerk of course that he/she intends to scratch from that final's event within 30 minutes of the announcement of the qualifiers.
2. Swimmers may reverse their intention to scratch and choose to be seeded for finals if they do so within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the preliminary session for that day.
3. Any swimmer in a championship or consolation final who fails to swim that event will be barred from their next individual event, excluding finals and relays, in which he/she is entered unless excused by the meet referee due to one of the exceptions below.
4. A swimmer not originally qualified for the championship or consolation final that is seeded into a final due to a scratch of another swimmer will not be penalized for failing to swim in that final.

No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if:

1. The referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
2. It is determined by the referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

Declared False Starts:

Declared false starts and/or a deliberate delay of meet will be treated the same as "failure to swim".

- NOTE 1: Alternates wishing to swim in an open lane in finals must be standing at the starters stand, ready to step on the blocks for his/her swim, when the swimmers are called to the blocks. Only the starter will call for the alternate, not the announcer.
- NOTE 2: Finals/Consolation Finals scratches must be done individually; 'team' scratches will not be accepted.
- NOTE 3: In addition to the swimmers being required to scratch if they are not going to swim in finals, all swimmers seeded 17-24 who do not wish to swim in finals are strongly urged to scratch.

Deck Registration: Deck Registration will not be permitted.

On-Line Meet Entry (OME) - Entries will be processed using the USA Swimming On-Line Meet Entry System (OME) ONLY. Access this entry system from the USA Swimming web site at the address <http://www.usaswimming.org/ome> Coaches must register for an account (Free) to utilize the system. Log in and select "Enter Team". **Paper, FAX, and Email entries will not be accepted.**

OME CLOSES: 12:00 PM (NOON) EST Wednesday, July 14, 2021

Late entries will be accepted up to 24 hours of OME closing and will be charged a \$100 processing + 2x the entry fee.

Entry Deadline:

Entries are to be completed through USA-S OME online entry, and it must be finished by pm (NOON). No faxed entries accepted. You may enter your swimmers prior to the entry deadline and close out those entries, to ensure the entries are accepted and still add to your entries based on swims from Last Chance Meets prior to the entry deadline.

Proof of Time:

Swimmers listed in the National Data Base with qualifying times achieved within the qualifying period (July 18, 2018 to July 14, 2021) will be permitted to swim individual events. Swimmers with qualifying times that are not listed in these data bases must provide proof of times. No conversions will be allowed. The swimmer must have achieved the qualifying time as published, in the type of course used to achieve the qualifying time.

Seeding:

All swimmers must enter with times achieved within the qualifying period. Nonconforming times will be seeded after short course yard qualifying times.

Seeding is as follows:
1. Long Course Meters
2. Short Course Yards

All events will be seeded and swum in the preliminaries fastest heats to slowest heats, unless otherwise noted in this meet letter.

- Team Representative:** Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach, who will check with the referee about any matter pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. This person must be a current member of USA Swimming/Florida Swimming to represent the team. For each team, the coach and that person only will be recognized.
- Identification:** Coaches and Officials shall wear their 2021 USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times during the swim meet or show current 2021 USA-S coach membership on Deck Pass.
- USA Swimming Insurance Safety Regulations require the swimming pool deck, during the operation of Florida Swimming, Inc. sanctioned meets, be closed to all persons except swimmers, coaches, marshals, officials and meet personnel. Credential tags must be presented to enter the pool deck area. Deck changing is prohibited.
- Camera Zones:** Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end." Etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, rest rooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.

COVID-19 SUPPLEMENT – INDIAN RIVER AQUATICS

This Plan Subject to Change or Modification Without Notice

Upon arrival at Indian River State College campus:

- If any athlete or staff member is symptomatic, he/she SHOULD NOT be permitted to travel.
- Teams will enter the facility using the south gates of the complex.
- Spectators will enter the facility for “viewing only” using the north gates of the complex.

Upon entry into the Aquatic Complex

- All teams may select their area on the lower pool deck for swimmers to remain when not competing. While in this area all athletes must wear masks and remain social distanced from other teams.
- Locker rooms will be monitored by staff and/or volunteers to assure no congregation occurs. The locker room facility should be used for basic restroom needs, not showering.
- If teams need to change due to travel, the locker room will be available. Masks are required in the locker room at all times and all are required to practice social distancing.

During Warm-Up

- Only members of your respective teams should be in your assigned warm-up lanes.
- Controlled warm-up will be at the discretion of meet management.

During Competition

- Fly-Over starts will be used during the competition to assist with social distancing.
- A staging area will be set-up to assist with the flow and social distancing. Masks must be worn in the staging area until it is the swimmer’s time to get on the starting block.
- The current heat will be on the block, the heat next up will be under the covered area on the south end of the pool. Heats will advance forward as the meet progresses heat by heat.
- Once the previous heat has exited the block area, the next heat will advance forward.

Spectators

- Spectators will be allowed on the pool deck in designated areas for viewing races. Chairs will be allowed in the viewing areas; however, no tents will be permitted. Tents should be placed outside the north spectator gate in any of the grass area outside the pool area.
- Spectators are asked to practice social distancing. Any spectator on the deck during the competition must wear a mask.
- The entry gate at the north end of the pool will be open for spectator entry into the facility.
- Restrooms in the Science Center (N Building) will be available for use throughout the competition.
- The pool deck has a limited number of bleachers in the spectator area under awnings. These benches may be used for spectator seating and are on a first come, first served basis. Management requests those seated in this area practice social distancing when on the bleachers. If an individual remains within the bleacher area, a mask covering both the nose and mouth is required at all times.

COVID-19 SUPPLEMENT - SARASOTA SHARKS

This Plan Subject to Change or Modification Without Notice

1. SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS

- We will have one entry and one exit; please social distance (6 feet apart) as you move through the facility. Teams will be assigned specific seating areas. (a seating diagram will be provided once all entries have been received)
- Teams will be assigned designated warmup lanes for pre-session warmup, and swimmers will maintain social distance in their lanes with no congregating at the ends of the lane.
- Coaches will supervise social distancing in the pool; designated social distance volunteer marshals will assist in supervising social distancing in the assigned spectator and athlete seating areas.
- Individuals should not come to the facility if they have a fever or have felt ill in the last 24 hours. If you feel ill, please get tested and report positive tests to your coach ASAP. Please take your temperature before you walk in/leave house. A staff member may ask and record the information.
- The locker rooms will be available for athletes to use the restroom and change. There will be a limited number of individuals allowed at any one time. One person per shower stall. We strongly encourage changing/showering at home.
- A limited number of spectators will be allowed inside the facility. Spectator areas are separate from athlete/coaches areas.
- The water monster will be available for athletes/coaches/officials, and users will be required to use hand sanitizer before and after. All attendees are encouraged to bring water from home.
- Swimmers should bring their own gear. There is no community equipment available (i.e. kickboards).
- Individuals not following the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the facility.

2. SPECTATOR PROTOCOLS

- Depending on the number swimmers, there may be a limited number of spectators allowed in the venue at any time during the meet to ensure social distancing.
- Spectators will be required to maintain 6 feet of social distance from all individuals not living in the same home. Spectators will be required to wear masks at all times, without exception. Those unable to comply with the published safety protocols for any reason should plan to watch the event from outside the venue.
- Tents and chairs are acceptable outside the fence, but county social distancing requirements must be adhered to at all times.

3. PERSONNEL EXPECTATIONS

- We have a very large, open-air venue and are able to break it into several distinct sections that also allow for 6 feet of social distancing. We expect to limit the maximum personnel inside the venue to 300 at any one time.
- All attendees will be required to agree to a COVID-19 waiver as well as agree to all Safety Protocols. Individuals not following safety protocols will be asked to leave the facility.

4. SAFE SPORT CONSIDERATIONS

- Parents will have access to the County lot behind the pool where they can park and observe the meet. They will be able to observe their children both in the seating area, in the pool and will also be able to view the scoreboard depending on where they elect to set up outside the facility.
- Parents will be able to communicate directly with their children through the fence if required.

5. COMPLIANCE ATTESTATION

- In applying for this sanctioned event, the Host, the Sarasota Sharks Inc, agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Florida Swimming, the State of Florida and the county of Sarasota.

6. MODIFICATIONS TO SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- In the event of new government, health department or venue guidance, these safety protocols may be modified at any time to ensure the safety of all personnel.
