

Important Meet Highlights (Please also read complete Covid safety procedures included in this packet as well):

- **Anyone not following face covering and social distancing guidelines will be warned once. After 1st warning, will be removed from the meet & facility. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **All Swimmers, spectators, coaches, officials and volunteers MUST wear face coverings and practice social distancing inside building. Only exception is when drinking or for swimmers when in the water. Per Klein ISD policy, face shields may not to be used in place of a face covering.**
- **Spectator Limitations due to current capacity restrictions:**
Friday Night Session – No spectators to allow for more swimmers to be in the meet session.
Saturday & Sunday - Spectators limited to 1 per family. Must have a swimmer in the session. There will be a check-in area at the door for spectators as they enter building. A person counts as a spectator no matter their age.

We realize that some families have multiple swimmers in the meet and because of the way the meet was divided up, may have swimmers in multiple sessions and some of the sessions are back-to-back. In order to accommodate that situation, if a family has multiple swimmers in the meet in different sessions, the swimmer not in the session may enter the natatorium even if it is not their session to swim and will not count as that family's 1 spectator. They must be entered in the meet and on the meet roster that will be at the door for check-in. This does not change that families are still not able to bring additional siblings in the family that are not entered in the meet, as those additional siblings would count as a spectator and only 1 spectator per family is allowed.

Volunteers do not count as a spectator and must check in at volunteer check in table when entering building. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your shift time, and exit the building when your shift is over.

- Swimmers should bring a small Ziploc bag with their name on it to the meet each day. They will place their face covering in the bag when they approach the block area to swim and the bag will be placed in a basket behind their lane. After they swim, they will retrieve their bag from the basket and put their mask on before exiting block area. Swimmers should plan on bringing an extra Ziploc bag and face covering if possible, in case theirs gets wet or lost.
- Swimmers and spectators will only be in pool area. No other parts of school will be open.
- This meet will be a pre-seeded. No circle in for any events.
- There will be no on-deck entries at this meet.
- For the 500 Free, each swimmer will be required to supply a lap counter (which will need to be another swimmer in the meet).
- No concessions or hospitality room for coaches/officials at the meet.
- Swimmers must enter and leave the facility in their swimsuits. **Locker rooms and restrooms will be for restroom use only. No changing allowed in facility.** Restrooms in locker rooms are for swimmer use only, and only 1 swimmer allowed in at a time. Other restrooms are limited to 2 at a time in the restrooms.
- Everyone will exit the building through the exit doors just past the restrooms. This is a separate set of doors than the entrance doors.

All of these procedures are required to be in place, so please cooperate and follow them to help us make the meet run smoothly!
