Championship Meet Suits: 13-14: Carbon Racing, 11-12: Powerskin ST 2.0 (Powerskin also comes in a classic cut without the leg). The Powerskin also comes in youth sizing so the youth 22 is like a kid's size 6 and a 28 is like a kid's 12.

CA COMPETITION SUIT POLICY

In developing the CA swimwear policy, the coaching staff has attempted to accomplish five objectives:

1. Abide by [USA Swimming Rules on Technical Suits for 12 & younger swimmers](#).
2. Maintain our philosophy of preparing our athletes to compete at the next level of competition.
3. Allow our swimmers to be competitive at their most important meet of the season.
4. Be considerate of our CA families and the costs of competition swimwear.
5. Arrive at meets looking like a team.

There are several factors that determine the type of suits our CA swimmers will wear during competition including the swimmer's age, physical development, swimming efficiency, level of competition, fit, and cost. For most of the season, the standard CA team suit will be the team suit. Any deviation from this would be the direct result of a specific coaches' decision for a specific swimmer.

Please remember that CA and arena are partners. Our swimmers should not wear any **suit, cap, or other team gear** that bears the logo or insignia of another swimwear company (i.e. Speedo, TYR, Nike, etc.) for competitions.
