T-5: Proposed Southeastern Championship qualification standards for disabled swimmers.

Proposed by Rayleen Soderstrom

1. Proposed that a swimmer with a classifiable disability may qualify for Southeastern Championships by obtaining a qualifying time for any age group. Scoring shall be by the swimmer's age. Appropriate seeding to be determined by the meet referee. A National Championship qualifying time will act as a Southeastern Championship qualifying time for a swimmer with a classifiable disability.

2. Any swimmer wishing to be considered for selection to the zone team not meeting the above criteria shall be encouraged to swim in the district championships or a suitable number of LSC meets

c) Using Hy-Teck High Point System for Zone Team Selection.

Discussed, decided to use this Summer Selections as a test run for comparison between the present selection mode and the Hy-Teck High Point System.
