

Ohana, High School & Other Teams – What Results Count for USA Swimming?

- **NWAL/ANY SUMMER LEAGUE** – These times do NOT count for Ohana/USA Swimming
- **MIDDLE SCHOOL MEETS** – These times do NOT count for Ohana/USA Swimming
- **PREVIOUS USA TEAMS** – These times DO count for Ohana/USA Swimming
- **UNAT/USWIM** – During the 120 day transfer period between teams, the times DO count for Ohana/USA Swimming
- **HIGH SCHOOL** (UIL and Private Schools)

1. The high school or private school coach MUST enter meets with the athletes USASwimming ID#. This is the MMDDYYFFMLLLL (Birthday and Letters of First, Middle and Last Names). If the coach does not ask for this season early season, parents will need to inquire and ensure entries use ID #.

2. Not ALL meets will count for USA. Only “observed” meets with USA swimming officials on deck “observing”. When this happens the results will be loaded by the host into USA Swimmings SWIMS database. However, this does NOT load into Ohana’s system.

3. To get the results into Ohana’s system, we (the team coach, Ohana staff and athlete parents) must work together to get them in. Usually requires some tracking down of .cl2 files.

4. NOTE: Once a meet is signed off as over by the head referee nothing can be changed so no retroactive entering of USA ID #s is possible.
