Condition of Sanction:

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C. The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, accompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA-S Vice President of Program Operations.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that the understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

COVID-19:

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.

COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. Type of Meet:

Age Group/Senior Open, 25-yard short course timed finals

Host: Riptide Aquatics – Lakeland

Dates and Times: Saturday, June 25th – Sunday, June 26th
Morning sessions will start at 9:00 AM both days
Afternoon sessions will begin 40 minutes after conclusion of morning session.

Warm-ups: AM Sessions - Saturday and Sunday – 7:30 am
PM Sessions - Minimum one-half hour warm-up prior to afternoon session start

Pool Specs: Certified 25-yard outdoor heated pool, non-turbulent lane lines, 10 lanes, water depth at start end 12ft & minimum turn end 4 ft. Paragon starting blocks, separate warm down area adjacent to competition pool.

Timing System: Electronic timing, manual backup watches, scoreboard display

Eligibility: Only swimmers currently registered with USA Swimming are eligible. On deck registration, will be allowed - 2022 USA-S form and fee must be presented to the Referee.

Entry Limit: Four (4) individual events per day plus relays. Swimmers over entered will be placed in the first 4 events in which they entered for that session. No limit on relays, relay entries should be labeled “A”, “B” etc.

Seeding: 25 Yard Short Course times, conversions using the formula in the current Florida Swimming handbook may be used for entry and seeding purposes.

Scratches: No Penalty for scratches on the block.

Entries: Entries must be in USA Swimming SDIF format or Hy-Tek CL2 format submitted by email using Hy-Tek team manager. Corrupted, unreadable, or incorrectly formatted files must be corrected within 24 hours. Errors in entries are the responsibility of the registering team. Any team who does not use the Hy-Tek meet entry format will be charged \$50. Electronic mail confirmation will be sent upon receipt of file. Preferred entry is via electronic mail attachment to: eva@fastswimresults.com. A signed hard copy printout dated the date of email submission also serves as proof of entry. The legal name and current USA Swimming Registration Number for each swimmer must be listed on the Entry Form, including Relay Only swimmers. The master entry form must accompany the proof of entries and a current USA Swimming member must sign the form.

Deck Entries: Deck entries will be accepted by the meet referee or designated official 45 minutes prior to the session start. The deck entry fee is \$10.00 per event plus facility fee if not already entered in meet and must be paid at the time of request. Deck entries will be accepted if space is available, or on a “stand-by” basis. No new heats will be created. Swimmers must

comply with the entry requirements of the meet. A swimmer may not scratch an event to
deck enter another.

Individual Events - \$4.50 per event for all age groups
Relays - \$5.00 per entry
Heat Sheet Fee - \$3.00 per swimmer
Travel Surcharge - \$2.00 surcharge per out-of-LCS swimmer

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules will govern the meet Safety rules as outlined by USA
Swimming, & recommended by the Head Marshall, will be in effect during all warm ups
& in all warm up areas. No recall false start will be used as outlined in 102.14.48. Flyover
starts will be used at the discretion of the head referee. Meet Management
reserves the right to cancel relays to be in accordance with the 4-hour rule.

Team Rep: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than a USA certified coach, who will check with the Referee about any matter pertaining to the meet may be given to the Referee. The coach and that person only will be recognized.

Supervision: A current coach member of USA Swimming must supervise each swimmer participating in a Florida Swimming sanctioned meet during warm up and competition. An unattached athlete or an athlete not escorted by a coach member must check in with the meet upon arrival at the meet. Such athletes must find a substitute coach who will supervise him/her during warm up and competition.

Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming credentials in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet or prove registration through Deck Pass.

Camera Zones: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end". Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined by Rule 239-2.

Conduct: Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

WARM UP SCHEDULE

Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach. **NO EQUIPMENT IS PERMITTED** General warm ups start at 7:30 am - lanes 1-10 circle swimming. 8:30 am-9:00 am controlled warm ups -lanes 1,2,6,9 & 10 one way only. Circle swimming lanes 3,4,5,7 & 8. Warm-ups are subject to change by Meet Management.
