<b>FACILITY:</b>	Georgia Tech McAuley Aquatic Center Campus Recreation Center 750 Ferst Drive Atlanta, GA 30332  This facility seats 1,900 and contains both a competition pool and diving well. The competition pool is 50 meter by 10 lanes, with two movable bulkheads so that courses can be set up for 25 yards or 25 meters. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming & Georgia Swimming. The water depth of the pool is 9 1/2 feet at start end and 9 1/2 feet at turn end. (measured from a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 mtr) to 16'5" (5mtrs) from both end walls).
<b>SCHEDULE:</b>	Saturday and Sunday – Seniors warm up at 7:00 AM, Starts at 8:00 AM 10&U and 11-12 warm up not before 12:30 with meet starting not before 1:30.
<b>MEET FORMAT:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All events will be Timed Final events. It is anticipated that double-ended (chase) starts will be used for this meet with odd numbered heats starting at the diving well end and even heats starting at the scoreboard end with all events seeded fastest to slowest.</li></ul>

<b>ENTRY FEES:</b>	EVENT FEE: \$6.50 / EVENT -LATE ENTRIES: \$13.00 / Event. Time Trial Fee: \$10.00 / Event \$15.00 per swimmer facility charge. \$2.00 Georgia Swimming surcharge will apply to all non-Georgia LSC swimmers.
<b>AGE DIVISIONS:</b>	10&U, 11-12, Senior ( <b>Must be 11 and older to enter Senior events</b> )

<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	This event is a <b>Closed Meet</b> with participation by invitation only. Meet Management will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials or teams to participate in this meet. All coaches must be USA-registered and certified and will be asked to show their registration credentials at the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member in as provided in Article 302. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of registration and certification.
<b>ENTRIES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Swimmers may swim a maximum of five (5) individual events per day.</b></li> <li>• Deck entries can be made with the clerk of course up to 30 minutes before the start of the session for empty lanes only.</li> <li>• This meet will be limited to 475 swimmers for each morning session and 300 swimmers for each afternoon session. The meet committee reserves the right to accept additional entries based on projected timelines.</li> <li>• In order to help control session timelines <b>Time Standards</b> will imposed on all 200 meter events (see order of events section).</li> </ul>
<b>LATE ENTRIES:</b>	Late entries will be accepted at the meet for empty lanes only and will be entered with “No Time”. Swimmers entering late must show proof of USA registration. Deck Pass is acceptable for proving registration.
<b>ENTRY SUBMISSION:</b>	Please submit entries via Team Manager/Unify. HY-TEK Meet Manager will be used. Send to <a href="mailto:jimyoung1@mindspring.com">jimyoung1@mindspring.com</a> ). Be sure to send hard copy of entries and check by mail to Megan Davis at above address.. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club Code and each swimmer’s USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time for each event entered.
<b>DECK-SEEDED EVENTS: 400 IM and 400 Free</b>	The 400 IM and 400 Free will be deck-seeded events limited to six heats each of women and men with check-in time for both being 9:00 AM on the days they are to be contested. The 400 IM and 400 Free will be swum slowest to fastest if chase starts are used with all women’s heats starting at the diving well end and all Men’s heats starting at the scoreboard end. If chase starts are not used then these events will be run fastest to slowest alternating women/men. The meet committee reserves the right to increase the number of heats swum in these events if the timeline permits. The meet committee reserves the right to deck-seed the 200 meter events as per the above stated limits in order to maintain a reasonable time line if deemed necessary.
<b>TIME TRIALS:</b>	Time trials will be run at the discretion of the Referee based on available time and officials. Time trial events count toward the five event limit per day. The time trial event schedule will be determined by the meet referee based on requests
<b>RULES:</b>	<p><b><a href="http://www.gaswim.org">Georgia Swimming Tech Suit Policy</a> - refer to <a href="http://www.gaswim.org">www.gaswim.org</a></b>  <b>Select: Meets/Events from the home page to review full policy</b>  <b>Revised: Effective April 1, 2019</b>  In all Georgia Swimming Sanctioned or Approved competitions, the use of Tech Suits as defined below will NOT be allowed by any 12&amp;Under athletes (whether competing in age-specific or “Open” events). 11-12 swimmers only will be allowed to wear Tech Suits at meets determined as Championship meets in the LSC such as Divisionals, State Championships, and Age Group Sectionals.</p> <p>The current USA Swimming, Inc., rules will govern the conduct of this meet unless otherwise noted.</p> <p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p>

	<p><b>Deck changes are prohibited.</b> (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.</p> <p>On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.</p> <p>Dive-over starts and chase starts may be used if deemed necessary by the meet management.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program &amp; Events Committee Chair or designee.</p> <p>Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.</p> <p>Swimmers will be responsible for swimming in their assigned heat and lane.</p> <p>Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.</p> <p>Swimmers entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a member coach must report to the Meet Referee or Meet Director, prior to the beginning of swimming activities to arrange for coach supervision of warm up, competition and warm down during the meet.</p>
<b>COACHES:</b>	<p>Coaches will be required to sign in and show their USA Swimming coaches registration card or <b>DECK PASS</b> for verification that all certifications are current.</p> <p><b>Coaches Meeting: 6:45 AM Saturday in the Hospitality room.</b></p>
<b>OFFICIALS:</b>	<p>The Meet Hosts welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. There will be an official's meeting one (1) hour prior to the start of each session. The official's uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and shoes. All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; <b>OR</b> a recently completed Apprentice Form; <b>AND</b> proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.</p>
<b>MEET COMMITTEE:</b>	<p>The Meet Committee shall be established during the coaches meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, Coaches and athlete members, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2018 USA Swimming Rulebook)</p>
<b>AWARDS:</b>	<p>There will be no awards for this event but all participants will receive a Betsy Dunbar meet cap.</p>
<b>SCORING:</b>	<p>There will be no scoring for this event.</p>
<b>CONCESSIONS/HOSPITALITY</b>	<p>Basic concessions will be offered by Ga. Tech Snack Bar. Hospitality room for Coaches and Officials provided by Swim Atlanta.</p>

<b>GEORGIA WARM-UP POLICY:</b>	The Georgia Swimming approved warm-up guidelines will be followed for this meet. Warm-up lane assignments will be posted at the pool.
