FACILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoor 6 lane, 25-Yard pool, 9 feet deep at the start end and 4 feet deep at the turn end, equipped with non-turbulent lane lines. Two timers will be used in every other lane utilizing two Colorado CTS buttons and one manual stopwatch. • The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 104.2.2C(4).

ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all athletes on East Coast Aquatic Team who are registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet. • 2021-2024 NAG time standards are in effect. • Age on November 7, 2020 will determine age for the entire meet.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. • The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All 12 and Under swimmers will swim in the morning session. All 13 and Up swimmers will swim in the afternoon session. All events will be timed finals.
WARM-UP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 8:00am; competition starts at 9:00am. Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups not before 12:00pm; competition starts not before 1:00pm. If the morning session runs late, the next session warm-ups will begin 20 minutes after the preceding session to allow for sanitizing/disinfecting.
ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS FRIDAY, October 30, 2020.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual event(s) each day. No deck entries will be accepted.
FEES:	<p>Individual events: \$4.00 per event Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)</p>
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers will be staged by heat assignments utilizing Social Distancing before each swim. Swimmers will be using every other lane for competition.
AWARDS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth (6) place
PENALTIES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Athletes should arrive in their suits. Locker rooms will not be available. All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening. Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks. The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.
TIMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be two timers per lane utilizing every other lane. Face masks are mandatory for all timers and counters. Each Swimmer will need to provide someone to count.
GENERAL:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own beverages and snacks for their session. Hospitality will be provided to officials and coaches. Heat sheets will be emailed to participants.
FACILITY RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NO SMOKING on the pool deck or in the spectator gallery. Each Team is encouraged to ensure the good conduct of swimmers in all areas of the building, including but not limited to locker rooms and hallways. NO GLASS containers are permitted in or around the pool area.
