FACILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 8-Lane, 25-Yard pool, 5 feet deep at the start end and 3 ½ feet deep at the turn end, equipped with Swim-Quip non-turbulent land markers. One timer will be used for each of the 25 yard races while the Automatic Timing System (2 buttons and 2 watches) will be used for all 50's. Lanes 1,3,5,7 will be used for the 50's.• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 104.2.2C (4).

ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open to all athletes 8 years old and younger from CGBD, CVAC, ECAT, ODAC and WAC registered prior to the first day of the meet.• No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.• 2021-2024 NAG time standards are in effect.• Age on November 14, 2020 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. • The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Events will be swum in Two sessions. Girls will be in session one. Boys will be in session two. • All events will be timed finals.
WARM-UP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Session: Warmups start at 7:30 am; competition starts at 8:10 am. • Second Session warmups start at 10:40am; competition starts at 11:20am. • Each team will be assigned a 15 min warmup. • Warmups will be assigned by lane and will be limited to 6 swimmers per lane, providing 10 feet of social distance in the lanes when practicable.
ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Thursday, October 29, 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entries must be submitted in short course yards times using Commlink-2 software- • Teams submit entries via e-mail. • A printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. • No Time (NT) and Coach Times (CT) will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT must be slower than a 10 & U "A" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. • 6 and under swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 events. 7 and 8 year old swimmers may swim a maximum of 5 events. • Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit or the limits as mandated by current Commonwealth of Virginia guidelines.
ENTRIES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which may require reseeding. • Email entries to: stevebialorucki@swimodac.com • Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Administrative Official on the provided forms.

Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. • IMPORTANT: If payment is sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airborne/UPS/etc., please ensure that a signature is NOT required for delivery as this will delay the receipt of your entries.
AWARDS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place in each event. • Awards will be given for each age group: 6 and under, 7 year olds and 8 year olds. • As both sessions of the meet will be combined and scored, all awards will be delivered to each team's designated coach no later than Monday morning. Results will be uploaded and posted to the Meet Mobile app Saturday afternoon.
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events will be pre-seeded with the 50 events being swum in lanes 1,3 and 5, 7.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Swimmers will be staged by heat assignment utilizing Social Distance markings before each swim.
PENALTIES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. ● Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. ● Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. ● If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. ● Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions. ● Athletes must arrive in their RACING suits. Restroom facilities are for EMERGENCY USE ONLY for all. Disinfecting products will be available at the sink area and must be used on any touched surface by each user. ● Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks at all times. ● Swimmers will be staged by heat assignment utilizing Social Distance markings before each swim ● Athletes and parents will enter through the door by the main hall way and exit through the gate at the far end of the pool. The entrance and the exit will clearly be marked. ● Athletes and families are to maintain proper social distancing. Participants and family members not adhering to this standard will be asked to leave the premises immediately. ● The Competition/pool deck will be open to 1 athlete's parent/guardian per swimmer during their child's race. NO siblings will be admitted on the pool deck. NO parents on deck during warmups. ● The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet. ● All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. ● Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian is responsible for ensuring compliance with this requirement. ● Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval ● The overhead start procedure will not be used for this meet. ● Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u> ● Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. ● Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. ● In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
