FACILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The Collegiate School Aquatic Center provides 2 indoor pools and supporting amenities including hospitality, a swim shop, classroom and wireless internet. ➤ The 50-Meter competition pool with bulkhead offers two 25 yard competition pools with a depth of seven feet and seven inches at the sides and eight feet two inches in the center. Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide swum wall to bulkhead. ➤ This meet will be swum in the 25 YARD course. ➤ Omega Starting Blocks, Colorado Timing GEN7 automatic and semi-automatic timing, backup Dolphin wireless stopwatches. ➤ The competition course has been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 104.2.2C(4). A copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming ➤ In participation in this meet, I and my minor athlete, hereby acknowledge and agree that participation in SwimRVA programs or activities comes with inherent risks. I have full knowledge and understanding of the inherent risks associated with SwimRVA participation, including but in no way limited to: (1) slips, trips, and falls, (2) aquatic injuries, (3) athletic injuries, and (4) illness, including exposure to and infection with viruses or bacteria. ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ This is an intrasquad competition that is open to all SwimVA athletes who are registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet. ➤ 2021-2024 NAG time standards will be in effect. ➤ Age on November 20th will determine age for the entire meet.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. ➤ The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ This meet will be the culminating meet in the Rapids Swim Series with all age groups competing in their in the session schedule below. 13 – 14 age group will be split between multiple sessions to achieve a safe athlete count for social distancing. There will be two sessions on Friday Evening and 3 each day on Saturday and Sunday. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Friday Afternoon: 11 – 12 and 13 – 14 Boys ➤ Friday Evening: 13 – 14 Girls and 15 & Over ➤ Saturday & Sunday Morning: 10 & Under ➤ Saturday & Sunday Mid: 11 – 12 and 13 – 14 Boys ➤ Saturday & Sunday Afternoon: 13 – 14 Girls and 15 & Over ➤ All events will be timed finals.
SCREENING, CHECK-IN and WARM-UP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All athletes and parents need to report to the screening station upon arrival. Parents will receive a wrist band once they are screened. Athletes will be checked in for the meet. ➤ SWIMMERS FAILING TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE SESSION. MINOR ATHLETES WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. PARENTS MAY SUBMIT THEIR ATHLETE'S SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL BY EMAIL TO HEALTHSCREENING@SWIMRICHMOND.ORG ➤ Friday Afternoon Session: Athlete screening and Check-in at 2:30 – 3:00 pm under the patio tent on the east side of the facility. Warm-ups at 3:00 – 3:30 pm, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 2:50 pm; competition starts at 3:45 pm. ➤ Friday Evening Session (all times estimated): Athlete screening and Check-in at 5:45 – 6:15 pm under the patio tent on the east side of the facility. Warm-ups at 6:15 – 6:45 pm, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 6:10 pm; competition starts at 7 pm. ➤ Saturday & Sunday Morning Session: Athlete screening and Check-in at 7:00 – 7:30 am under the patio tent on the east side of the facility. Warm-ups at 7:30 – 8:00 am, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 7:25 am; competition starts at 8:15 am. ➤ Saturday & Sunday Mid-Day Session (all times estimated): Athlete screening and Check-in at 10:15 – 10:45 am under the patio tent on the east side of the facility. Warm-ups 10:45 – 11:15 am, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 10:40 am; competition starts at 11:30 am. ➤ Saturday & Sunday Afternoon Session (all times estimated):: Athlete screening and Check-in at 2:00 – 2:30 pm under the patio tent on the east side of the facility. Warm-ups at 2:30 – 3:00 pm, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 2:25 pm; competition starts at 3:15 pm. ➤ If any prior session runs late, the next check in will begin 15 minutes after conclusion of the morning session to give staff time to disinfect the facility. The Meet Director Reserves the right to move start times earlier or later after entries are received and the meet is streamlined.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Swimmers 10 & Under may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual events per session</i>. ↗ Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit or the limits as mandated by current Commonwealth of Virginia guidelines. ↗ No deck entries will be accepted
FEES	\$10 per event entered in the SwimRVA Rapids Swim Series Finale.
VIDEO SERVICE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ SwimRVA continue to offer the SPIIDEO video service in the main arena. The service will be available for the meet at no charge to SwimRVA families. Families will be able to stream the service on their smart phone or device from anywhere they have service. This will be a fantastic addition to our social distancing guidelines and allow for viewing the races from the outdoor seating areas or anywhere in the world!
VIRGINIA PHASE THREE GUIDELINES ATHLETE SEATING, SPECTATOR SEATING AND REPORTING TO THE STARTING BLOCKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ VIRGINIA PHASE THREE GUIDELINES: Spectators, athletes, coaches, and officials not in the same household are also required to maintain 10 feet of social distance. Lastly, spectators, athletes, coaches, and officials are required to wear a face mask at all times inside the venue when not swimming. ↗ OUTSIDE SEATING (see map): Outside the venue the event is limited to 250 persons (see map). Spectators, athletes, coaches, and officials not in the same household need to maintain 10 feet of social distance while outside the venue. SwimRVA will have speakers with the arena PA in the outdoor seating area. The announcer will announce heats and events. The announcer will also call athletes to the arena for their event when three heats prior to the race in the water. ↗ THERE WILL BE NO INDOOR SEATING FOR SPECTATORS OR ATHLETES unless weather dictates the need to do so. ↗ In the event that athletes are seated indoors, they will be assigned socially distanced spaces in the mezzanine. SwimRVA will communicate any changes in seating and all associated maps and rules by Wednesday, November 18th. ↗ REPORTING TO THE STARTING BLOCKS: SwimRVA will have speakers with the arena public address in the outdoor seating area. The announcer will announce heats and events. The announcer will also call athletes to the arena for their event three heats in front of their race. Athletes should report to the arena through the northeast entry doors and ready themselves in the corresponding location on the north wall. Heat in the water, next heat on deck at the northwest corner of the competition pool, second heat in the next wait zone, third heat in the next wait zone. It is the athlete's responsibility to report to the blocks and corresponding location when it is time to compete.
SEEDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Heat sheets will be distributed electronically at no cost. ↗ All events will be pre-seeded. ↗ SWIMMERS FAILING TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM IN THE SESSION. MINOR ATHLETES WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
SCORING	<p>Individual events will be scored in the following order: 9 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Only the top 3 athletes from any team per age group will be eligible to score points in any single event.
AWARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Awards will not be distributed. Scoring will be broken out by age group.
PENALTIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. ○ Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. ○ Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. ↗ If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. ↗ Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Athletes must arrive in their suits. Locker rooms will not be available.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening ↗ Lobby restrooms and Swim and Tri swim shop are open for anyone wearing a mask and able to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions. ↗ All Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks. ↗ The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. ↗ Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. ↗ Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. ↗ Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. ↗ Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. ↗ An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. ↗ In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
OFFICIALS	<p>Meet Referee: Ralph Jones Email: ralph.jones@vdot.virginia.gov</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Officials will be needed for all positions and all sessions for this meet. ↗ ALL OFFICIALS AND COACHES MUST CHECK IN AT THE HEALTH SCREENING STATION PRIOR TO ENTERING THE POOL DECK. ↗ COACHES AND OFFICIALS MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES WHILE INSIDE THE FACILITY. ↗ Officials meeting will be one hour prior to the start of each session. The meeting will take place on the east side of the competition pool deck.
SAFETY	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.
TIMERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ There will be one timer assigned per lane. Timer shifts will be assigned based on entries and the length of each session. Timer brief will take place 15 minutes prior to the start of the session. ↗ Timers should enter the building at the east competition pool entry doors. (SEE MAP)
GENERAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↗ Swim and Tri swim shop will be available in the lobby. ↗ Hospitality will be limited to water and prepackaged snacks. ↗ There will not be concessions offered at the contest.
