

## Vallejo Aquatics Dual Meet Safety/Covid Protocols

- A. VJO will adhere to all Solano County Health Department and City of Vallejo regulations and policies related to pool use during Covid-19. The Meet Director and other meet personnel will insure this through our monitoring plans during the event and also monitor local authority regulations for any updates leading up to the meet. The event will be held at John f. Cunningham Aquatic Complex, 801 Heartwood Avenue, Vallejo, CA 94589. This event is NOT open to the public.
- B. Spectators -
  - Spectators may view competition outside the venue through the north fencing.
  - Spectators will wear masks and maintain 6 ft social distancing.
  - Spectators are allowed access to outside restrooms only.
  - Spectators must remain in the designated spectator area outside of the north fencing pool area with masks on.
- C. Safe Sport - Parents will have an unobstructed view at all times of children through the fencing.
- D. Maximum number of individuals allowed inside the facility as required by the City of Vallejo is 150 at any given time. This will be enforced by the Meet Director and Marshals.
- E. Athletes –
  - Enter through Northeast gate, social distancing and with masks on.
  - Athletes will have temperature checks and submit their COVID-19 questionnaire answers to the gate monitor.
  - Athletes will keep masks on at all times except when warm up, warming down and competing.
  - Athletes will each have their designated staging area 6-10 ft away from other attendees.
  - Athletes will be called to the blocks only after the previous heat has exited the starting area.
  - Athletes will leave the facility immediately after their last swim.
- F. Officials –
  - Will follow the same rules as the athletes in terms of entry and exit.
  - Will follow the Pacific and Zone 3 requirements regarding meet management during COVID-19.
- G. Timers –
  - Will follow the same entry and exit procedures as the athletes.
  - Timers are not to enter the pool area any sooner than 20 minutes prior to the start of the meet.
  - Timers will be staged 6 ft apart. If touch pads are being used there will be one timer per lane. If touch pads are not used, only odd lanes will be run for competition with 2 timer per lane.
  - Timers will keep masks on at all times behind the blocks with chairs 6ft to 10ft from the starting blocks.
  - Timers will come forward to stopwatch and push timing system plunger and then immediate retreat back to their chairs.
- H. Meet workers –

- Will follow same entry/exit procedures as athletes.
- Will have masks on for the duration of the event.
- Will maintain social distance at all times.
- All rules and procedures will be communicated in advance to all attendees.
