



# NOTES ON UPCOMING MEETS

**Hey BACers. GREAT job to all who swam at Spooktacular, and a big thank you to all of the volunteers that helped run the meet. Here's some info and the basic rundown on some upcoming meets!**

## **VAST TRICK OR TREAT MEET**

The meet deadline for VAST passed last week. We expect to get information from the meet host and to send out a one page 'info sheet' (just like we did for the Spooktacular) sometime next week, probably Wednesday or Thursday.

## **HOLLAND BUS TRIP**

THERE ARE STILL SPOTS AVAILABLE! We were initially worried about overfilling our capacity for the bus or for the hotel block, and we consequently had a really quick turnaround for the sign-up. Right now we have a few spots – about 10 – left open for swimmers that might have missed the initial opportunity but are still interested. ## **WGLO & MSS ROCKSTAR**

We lumped these meets together because they're the same weekend, and we want families to consider this weekend as a 'highly recommended' weekend where our BACers compete at either one or the other. Both meets were just posted to the web, so families can sign up now!

- **WGLO:** This is our first 'time standard' meet of the year, where swimmers have to have times that are fast enough to qualify. The standards for this meet are actually harder than the State Meet standards for some age groups and events. *We've attached an eligibility report* that shows the current qualified swimmers and their events. Swimmers can add more cuts at VAST or even at Holland
- **MSS ROCKSTAR:** This is a great local meet for swimmers not attending the WGLO. Swimmers can do any/all days but should limit to one session each day. It's also a great chance for swimmers to try some events that they maybe didn't feel ready to do at the Spooktacular or VAST meets.
- **THE DEADLINE FOR BOTH MEETS IS THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup>**
- Many of our groups will be preparing differently for this weekend (a little rest, a little more focus on meet skills) than other meets with the expectation that this weekend produces some of the fastest times of the fall session!

## **BAC HOLIDAY SPLASH**

This meet was originally slated to be at Middleton, and we're working with them to see what could possibly work. We may be able to hold the meet there, or we may have to seek a different venue. We'll also possibly have some format changes depending on what gets figured out. We should know more next week and we'll communicate that out ASAP.

## **12-U SINGLE AGE STATE**

Looking ahead a bit, this is the first 'LSC Championship Meet' of the fall-winter SCY season. It's a newer meet (year #5) and this year we are THRILLED to be hosting it at the Verona Natatorium. We'll have a LOT more information on the meet in coming weeks, but for now we've attached an early eligibility report.
