Please be advised that due to the depth of the non-starting end of the pool, the 2nd and 4th leg of all 100-Yard/Meter relays will start in the water.

Pool: 6 lane, 25 yard flush deck, non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags with 30 inch starting blocks. The pool is 11' deep at the starting end and 3.5 feet at turn end. The Competition Course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2C(4).

Timing: Colorado timing system with back-up buttons and watches.

Official Rules: All current USA and WI Swimming Rules and Regulations apply. All USA and WI Swimming Safety Rules will be strictly enforced. Swimmers must be registered USA-S swimmers with swimmer's age as of October 16, 2016. Non-LSC entrants must bring current USA Swimming membership cards to meet.

Warm-up: The procedure for warm-ups will be the first 35 minutes as a circle swim in lanes 1-6. The last 25 minutes will be sprints in lanes 3, 4, 5 and 6 and circle swim in lanes 1, 2.
Swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end feet first using a three point entry for warm-up. Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures are subject to disqualifications.

Entry Limit: Swimmers must swim all five events included in the pentathlon to be eligible for high point trophies. Swimmers may swim in fewer events if desired. Entry Limit 5 Individual Events & 1 Relay. Deck seeding will be allowed in empty lanes only.

- Entry Deadline:** The Entry Chair must receive entries **no later than Friday, October 7, 2016**. No phone entries will be accepted. Waiver and fees should be received by Tuesday, **October 11, 2016**. This meet will be run with Hy-Tek software. No seed times will be changed once the entry chair has seeded the meet. **13 & 14 and OPEN events may be combined but would still be awarded separately.**
- Fees:** Entry fees are **\$4.00** for individual events, **\$12.00** per relay, plus **\$3.00** splash fee. For swimmers swimming in all five events in the pentathlon fees will be discounted \$2 for a total of \$21 with splash fee. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Make checks payable to: Beloit Aquatic Team, Inc. Fees are non-refundable.
- Disabled Swimmers:** If you have swimmers with special needs, please notify the Meet Director no later than Wednesday, October 12, 2016.
- Final Results:** Final results will be emailed to all competing teams and posted at www.wisconsinswimming.org and www.swimstateline.com.
- Awards:** High Point trophies for first, second and third place to boys and girls from each age group (8 &U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, & Open) for best composite times. Any swimmers entering the Open Events will compete for the Open High Point trophies regardless of age. Ribbons will be awarded for individual events to first through eighth place and first through third for relays.
- Admissions:** Spectators over 13 years are \$3.00. Heat sheets are \$3.00.
- Concessions:** Food and Beverages will be available.
- Conduct:** Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- Video Use:** Use of cell phones or any other device that has video recording capabilities is NOT PERMITTED in the locker room or bathroom areas.
- Timers:** STAT may require teams to provide timers based on number of entries and need. In the event timers are required they will not be charged admission for the sessions they time at.
