3 - Inside Left (delete)

Charlie: 7-10 (1st-4th grade)

The Charlie level is for swimmers new to the competitive swim and have had experience in pre-competitive lessons. This level is also done in conjunction with Stroke Clinic at Catch the Wave Swim Club to better perfect their technique for competition.



4 - Inside Middle (delete)

Bravo: 10-14 (5th -8th grade)

The Bravo level is for athletes that have 1 or more years of competitive swimming experience and can perform all 4 strokes in competition without disqualification. Stroke Clinic at Catch the Wave Swim Club may be required on a as need basis if there are major technique aspects needing to be addressed.



5 - Inside Right (delete)

Alpha: 14 and up (High School and College)

The Alpha level is for Athletes entering high school and/or in high school looking to maximize their highest potential! These athletes can perform all facets of competitive swim without disqualification.
