

HSSB Locker Room Usage Policy

Be sure to follow these guidelines for everyone's safety, security, comfort and convenience.

- Be respectful of your teammates and other pool patrons at all times.
- Destructive behavior will not be tolerated. Any expenses associated with cleaning or repairs will be assessed to the parent of the swimmer(s) involved.
- Parents are responsible for their swimmers as soon as practice ends.
- Place your belongings (including backpacks, jackets, shoes, etc.) in a locker. Do not leave belongings on the floors or benches in the locker rooms during practice as space is limited.
- Use of cell phones or cameras in the locker room area is prohibited.
- Swimmers should arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before the start of their scheduled practice and should be out of the locker room 15 minutes after their practice ends.
- Limit showers to no more than 10 minutes.
- Leave your belongings in a locker or on the floor while showering and changing. Bench space is a valuable commodity, so try not to use more than your needed share.
- Keep shampoo and soap in the shower areas. It is not safe to bring suds into the drying and changing areas. Dry off in the designated drying areas. Try to keep the floor of the changing rooms dry.
- Turn off the showers when you are done.
- Keep voices in a conversational tone. Appropriate language and content should be used at all times, especially with the younger swimmers in the locker rooms.
- Clean up and dry your area as much as possible when you are done changing.
- Do not bring food in the locker rooms.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to check on their (same gender) children while they use the locker rooms. The coaches are not responsible for the swimmers at that time.
- As the weather gets warmer, please be careful outside the pool area. The parking lot is very busy.
- Parents, please drive carefully in the parking lot.
