COVID-19:

All participants must adhere to the meet marshalls' instructions. Participants including family members not adhering to this standard will not be able to race and must leave the premises immediately - no refund. Electronic command whistles will be used.

Athletes and their families will be able to view the meet via YouTube Live. Athletes will be seated around the pool area, distanced and wearing masks when not racing or warming up / down.

Participants must not be ill, must not have a family member who is ill, and in addition, athletes and their siblings must not feel nauseous, lethargic or low energy.

Each team must have a person who will conduct ingress screening questions prior to each athlete's participation each day of the meet to include: "Are you unwell, is anyone you live with unwell, are you nauseas, lethargic, or low energy?"

Masking recommendations will follow the guidance from NGB, WI Swim, CDC, State or Local Health Dept. This guidance will be communicated after Monday Dec 7, 2021

General Meeting: Saturday, December 11, TBA. Additional coaches' meetings may be held as determined by the Meet Referee. It is the responsibility and obligation of each team or unattached swimmer to be represented at all Coaches' Meetings. Coaches or other team representatives are responsible for all information presented at these meetings including changes to the meet format or conduct. Coaches should check their team mailboxes prior to each session and look for postings where they pick up heat sheets.

Officials Meetings: Officials Meeting will be held one hour before the starting time for each session.

Rules and Procedures

Official Rules: Official current USA Swimming and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail for this meet except as otherwise specified in this meet information. Swimmers must be registered USA and Wisconsin Swimming athletes..

Swimmer with a Disability: Please note any special requirements and/or requests for a swimmer by emailing or calling the meet entry chairperson.

Start Certification: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Further, those participants not proficient with a backstroke ledge must start each race from within the water, and without use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP") Acknowledgement: Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. An athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

Protests: For consideration of all other protests lodged at the meet, the Referee may appoint a meet jury. The jury shall consist of not fewer than three (3) and not more than five (5) persons, at least one of whom shall be a coach and one an athlete.

There may be assigned times and lanes for the warm-up sessions. The final warm-up schedule will be posted on the Schroeder YMCA Swim Team meet landing page. Sprint lanes will be opened and closed as necessary.

Circle swimming only, entry into the water shall be feet first, feet first entry for all warm ups, except in designated lanes and times. Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to the warm-up for lane assignments.

There will be continuous access to the south 25-yard pool for warm-up and warm-down throughout the meet.

Site Information

Location: Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center – 9240 North Green Bay Rd, Brown Deer, Wisconsin

Facility: The facility will be configured as 2 x 8-lane 25 YD competition pools with non-turbulent lane markers , backstroke flags and wedges. Pool depth at the starting end is 6'7" and 7' at the turn end. Block height is 29.5". The competition course has been certified. A copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming. A mix of SST and CTS will be used with dual scoreboard displays with touch pads, back-up buttons and back-up watches.

Swimmer Drop-off and Parking: There will be limited free parking in the West lot. There will be a \$5 Preferred Parking fee on the East side of the building. There is overflow parking available behind the Office Depot store in the shopping mall on Green Bay Road that is a short walk from the pool.

Deck access: USA Swimming membership is required for deck access. Coaches and officials must be able to produce credentials upon request. Non-athlete members are only allowed on deck for official business. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.

Spectators With Disabilities: Will be able to sit in chairs near mid pool on the east side of the facility. Their view may be obstructed.

Athlete and Parent Conduct:

Please follow the athlete and parent conduct guidelines below. Anyone not following these rules may be subject to removal from the meet and facility.

- Each team is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers and parents.
- Teams are asked to pick up any garbage in their immediate team area after each session.
- Only coaches, swimmers, and meet workers are allowed on deck and in the athlete bleacher section..
- No coolers, chairs, blankets or large bags will be allowed in the spectator area. Swimmers (and their bags) should sit in their team's area on the pool deck, not in the spectator stands.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited
- Flash photography and photography from behind the starting blocks are prohibited at the start of each race.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue. This includes pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms. Anytime athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair. 103.13/M/Drones

Entry into the Meet

Swimmer Eligibility: All swimmers must be Current Wisconsin LSC registered athlete members of USA Swimming. All individual swimmers entered in the meet shall be eligible to swim in the meet, having at least one verifiable qualifying time. Swimmers who cannot verify qualification for the meet with a proof of time will be withdrawn from the meet. Any swimmer who swims in the meet and is found ineligible will be disqualified from the meet, forfeit all awards and points achieved and their club fined \$200. There will be no deck entries or registration. The representative submitting entries shall be responsible for verifying that all swimmers satisfy these requirements.

Time Standards: Swimmers must meet 12 & Under Single Age State Championship qualifying times as set by Wisconsin Swimming, which are available at www.wisconsinswimming.org and included in the meet information.

Qualifying and Seed Times: **Qualifying period for this competition will be September 1, 2019 through the entry deadline.** DO NOT CONVERT. Qualifying time standards are included in this packet. Qualifying times will be accepted Short Course Yards, Short Course Meters and Long Course Meters. Non-conforming times will be seeded after SCY times. The order used for seeding will be SCY then SCM then LCM. If bonus swims are allowed, bonus entries will be seeded after qualified swims in the same course order.

Entries: Swimmers may compete in Four (4) individual events per day, plus relays up to a maximum of Six (6)

individual events for the meet.

Entry Deadline: Monday, **December 6th at 6:00 PM** CST. Entries received after the initial deadline may be accepted upon remittance of a \$100 late fee; no entry will be accepted after 6:00 PM CT Wednesday, December 8th.

Entry Procedures: Submit an entry file from Team Unify or Hy-Tek. If you need help submitting please contact the meet entry chair. Mark your bonus events in either Team Unify or Hy-Tek.

All Entry times for other than “bonus events” will be checked against SWIMS. Entry times not in SWIMS must be proven if the athlete fails to swim the time standard in the event. Proof of time can be HyTek or TU top times report, printed / viewable results from competitions. Submit proof of time prior by Tuesday, December 7th by mailing chernday@wsacitd.org after the meet entry times are compared against SWIMS with .pdf or other viewable results including - meet results or TU or Hy Tek top times report.

- List of acceptable proof of times is located in the “PROOF OF TIMES” section of this meet information.
- All outstanding proofs must be cleared by the “PROOF DEADLINE” Tuesday, December 7th, 2021 6:00PM

Proof of Times:

All entry times will be verified against the SWIMS database, if you use override (custom) times, you must provide all proof of times by 6:00 PM, Tuesday December 7th. Valid proof received after the deadline will be accepted upon remittance of a \$100 late fee. Unproven entries will not be seeded into the meet.

These proofs can be emailed to the Entry Chair before December 7th in order to expedite “clearing” proofs. [Links to published meet results from independent websites \(Wisconsin Swimming, YMCA, etc.\) and attached PDFs are the preferred method.](#)

Qualifying standards must be achieved by a swimmer in a meet providing printed or viewable meet results, e.g., meets from which times may be used are any USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed meets, YMCA closed competition..

Bonus Events: Any swimmer who has entered with one qualifying time may enter three bonus events for which they do not have a qualifying time. Any swimmer entered with two qualifying times may enter two bonus events. Any swimmer entered with three qualifying times may enter one bonus event. Any swimmer with four or more entered qualifying times is not eligible for bonus events. There is no bonus swim for swimmers that are “relay only” entrants in the meet.

Relay Entries: Teams may enter an “A” relay provided that they have an individual qualifier entered in that age group/gender. In order for a team to enter a “B” relay, the team must have at least eight (8) individual qualifiers in that age group/gender; a “C” relay must have at least twelve (12) individual qualifiers, etc. The other members of a team’s only relay entry in a given age group/gender may be relay-only swimmers. Relays that are not a team’s only relay for an age group/gender must be composed entirely of swimmers who are individually qualified for the meet.

Relay-only swimmers must be included in your entry. To add a relay-only swimmer after the entry deadline, the swimmers must be entered into the meet 20-minutes prior to the start of the session in which they will swim.

NOTE: If a swimmer who is entered as an eligible swimmer is found to be ineligible for the meet, that swimmer may not be part of a relay as a relay-only swimmer and does not count as a qualified swimmer for a relay.

Entry Fees: \$4.00 LSC Splash Fee per Swimmer
\$6.00 per individual event
\$16.00 per relay (Please note: **Relay-only swimmers MUST also pay the \$4.00 LSC splash fee.**)
\$12.00 Facility User Surcharge

Payment: A check for entry fees and surcharges must be received before the start of the meet, all payments will be made via check or cash, no credit cards will be accepted. Make checks payable to **WSAC**.

Psych Sheet and Session Reports: Initial Psych Sheets and session reports will be posted on the meet page by 12:00 PM CST on Tuesday, December 7th.

Format: All events are pre-seeded, timed finals. No events will be check in events. All swimmers must report to their blocks for the start of their heat. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized.

Breaks: There may be awards breaks. They will be added at the discretion of meet management and based on the size of the meet.

Deck Entries: Deck entries for individual events will not be accepted. USA Swim Registered Relay only swimmers can deck enter for relays no later than 20 minutes before the start of each session. The coach must give the information to the Meet Director and pay the appropriate fee(s). Deck USA Registrations will not be accepted.

Time Trials: There will not be time trials associated with this meet.

Swimmers with Disability: Swimmer athletes can enter any event (up to the limit of the meet information) but they must have achieved a Wisconsin Swimming State Time Standard OR the Disability Para Motivational Championship Time Standards (P1, P2, P3). Both sets of time standards can be found on Wisconsin Swimming's website (www.wisconsinswimming.org) Although swimmers with disabilities can enter any event(s) the only events that will be scored and awarded in Para categories are noted on the event page.

Contact the meet host when entering an athlete with a disability. Enter swimmer with actual time and qualification will be verified with the State Disability Chair. If coaches have any questions regarding the Disability inclusion at the State Championship, please email Wisconsin Swimming's Disability Chair. Information can be found on the Wisconsin Website (www.wisconsinswimming.org).

Meet Management may combine heats by gender; however, they will be scored separately.

USA Swimming defines a Disability as a permanent life affecting impairment/disability. This would include everything from a club foot through to children on the spectrum where it affects their reaction times, severe learning disabilities, etc. and everything in between. The two key components are that it must be permanent (recovery from surgery, a bad sprain, etc. is not acceptable) and it must affect their performance.

Awards and Scoring

Individual and Relay Awards: No awards will be mailed! (Awards not picked up at the meet will be brought to the April LSC meeting.)

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Medals: 1st – 8th, Ribbons: 9th – 16th

RELAYS: Medals: 1st – 3rd, Ribbons: 4th – 8th

STATE CHAMPION: T-shirts will be awarded to the winner in each event. (Limit one per swimmer.)

INDIVIDUAL HIGH POINT: 1st – 3rd male and female per age group.

Team Awards:

COMBINED TEAM AWARDS: 1st Place Combined Teams (all ages, male and female) by Division will be awarded at the conclusion of Sunday's PM session. 2nd and 3rd Place Combined Teams can order their awards through Hasty, if so desired.

Awards Presentations:

8 & Under, 9, 10, 11 and 12 Individual High Point and Team Champion awards will be presented at the conclusion of the meet.

Scoring: INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: 20 - 1 for 8-lane pool
RELAY EVENTS: Double Points
